Private College Embarks On New Curriculum Plan

Kalamazoo, Mich. (UPI)—Like all small private colleges, Kalamazoo college faced a major challenge in coping with fast-rising costs and an expected increase in student enrollment.

To meet the challenge the 750-student coed school embarked last fall on a bold curricula revision, switching from a two-semester academic year to a four-quarter plan. It was hailed as a revolutionary approach to the cost and space problem, but first indications are that it had a hidden bonus factor: dramatically improved student performance.

The object of the Kalamazoo plan, a combination of several ideas already in practice elsewhere, is to obtain a rich and varied educational experience while making existing classroom, dormitory and dining hall space stretch at least one-third farther.

The main features of the plan are three on-campus quarters a year with vacations spread among summer, fall, winter and spring; study at a foreign university and credit for non-resident quarters during which the student works for a business concern or social agency and pursues an independent study program. A typical student would be on-campus only 10 of his 15 undergraduate quarters, some of them summer quarters.

The result is that the college plant operates at full capacity year-around. The space goes even farther because of the time the students spend off campus.

Course Reduction

Another innovation was a reduction of courses undertaken simultaneously from four or five to three. Those courses were scheduled five days a week and out-of-class research work was assigned in addition to normal "homework."

At the end of the first two quarters under the new system, the college reported these results:

Ninety-nine students made the dean's list the first quarter and 103 the second, compared with 68 in last year's first semester.

The percentage of student dropouts was well under the average of the past six years.

Students studied more. Library circulation was up an average of 45 per cent over a year ago.

Dr. Weimer K. Hicks, president of Kalamazoo, said it was too early to pass positive judgment on the four-quarter plan, but he sensed "a new spirit of adventure" among students.

I've even succumbed to laboratory for laboratory.

Motions Filed in Schwensen's Behalf

Portland—UPI—Two motions on behalf of convicted slayer Richard B. Schwensen were filed by his attorneys here Tuesday.

One motion seeks a new trial on a number of grounds, including a claim that the jurors followed the progress of the trial closely in news papers. The second motion seeks to set aside the death verdict and dismiss the case because the state did not prove what caused the death of Mrs. Jean Rosaria Bussey.

A Circuit Court jury convicted Schwensen of felony murder—death resulting from rape or attempted rape. Mrs. Bussey's body was found in her parked car Sept. 25, eight days after she was seen leaving a bar with Schwensen.

The jury made no recommendation for mercy, making the death sentence mandatory.

The state has not yet replied to the motions. The court will set a hearing date later.
