World's Helicopter Distance Mark Claimed. Travis AFB, Calif. (AP)—An Air Force pilot today claimed a world's helicopter distance record, surpassing the previous mark held by a Russian flier. Capt. Chester R. Ratcliffe, 31, of Buffalo, N.Y., flew 900 miles Thursday from Ogden, Utah, to Springfield, Minn. He landed on a grassy strip after running out of fuel in his Kaman H-43B. The Russian record was 761 miles, set by a military helicopter.
