

Italy Joining Other European Nations in Upsurge of Liberal Party

Rome — (AP) — Italy, like Britain and West Germany, is experiencing a resurgence of the Liberal party, which had a doubled vote in recent local elections.

Liberalism in Europe and the United States does not mean the same thing. European Liberals are for a smaller, not larger, government role in public life. Observers believe one reason for the Liberal gains here is opposition to the Socialist trend of the present coalition government.

Giovanni Malagodi's Liber-

al party still is small compared to the Christian Democrats of Premier Amatore Fanfani or the left-wing Socialists of Pietro Nenni, now the main elements of the government coalition.

But in elections last month in Rome and other cities, the Liberals more than doubled their 1960 vote, polling about 250,000 of the 3,000,000 ballots cast.

Vote Not Wasted

Many observers believe the gains may have convinced the public that the party is not

destined for a permanent splinter role and thus would not be a waste of a vote.

From time to time since the war, the Liberals have joined the Christian Democrats in the national government. But since Fanfani's "center-left" alliance with the Socialists this year, they have been strongly in opposition.

Their avowed goal is to win votes from the Christian Democrats in next year's elections and thus force the ruling party to reverse its pro-Socialist stand.

In the last general elections

in 1958, the Liberals won only 3.5 per cent of the votes, and 17 seats in the 596-member Italian Chamber of Deputies. Since then, they have gained five seats through deputies elected on other tickets joining their ranks.

Offers Rejected

Although Malagodi is on the same side of the fence with the Monarchists and neo-Fascists in opposing the Fanfani coalition, he has rejected their offers of an alliance. He has stressed that his party is Democratic and will not join

with those that are not. His stand's success was reflected in the local election results, which showed gains at the expense of the Monarchists as well as the Christian Democrats.

Even the Communists and other left-wing parties, while sharply attacking the liberals, have publicly admitted their useful role in providing a non-Fascist alternative for Catholic voters who dislike Fanfani's leftward turn.

Malagodi, a former banker and government expert, has led the fight for people's capi-

talism in Italy. The Liberals take pride in being the sponsors of the first anti-trust bill ever brought before the Italian Parliament. It called for restrictions on state monopoly as well as private trusts.

For Private Enterprise

His legislative and campaign fights are for private enterprise, a market economy, an efficient administration, and less state intervention in the economy.

Liberal foreign policy is to work for the North Atlantic Treaty Organization and other

Italian links with its allies. Former Liberal Foreign Minister Gaetano Martino was among the chief sponsors of the European Common Market. The Liberals have fought for years against all forms of trade barriers and protectionism.

Like its counterparts in Britain and Germany — which also have scored gains in recent elections — Italy's Liberal party has a long and honored history.

It grew out of the 19th century Liberal party of Count Camillo Benso Di Ca-

vour, who played a leading role in the unification of Italy and brought it a balanced budget after near bankruptcy.

Party Collapsed

The Liberals remained the leading party in Italy until after World War I, supporting reforms including universal suffrage and labor legislation.

Weakened by the emergence of the mass Catholic and Socialist parties, the Liberal ruling class virtually collapsed after the war and Mussolini's Fascism replaced it.

Philosopher Benedetto Croce led the party in the liberation fight during the closing years of World War II and the party was among the six sharing early postwar governments.

Prominent postwar Liberals included the late Luigi Einaudi, Budget Minister who halted inflation and later became president.

Tourist Needs To Be Met by World Accommodations

New York — (AP) — A global hotel building boom is under way to meet the needs of a swelling number of travelers.

Across the United States, new hotels, motels and motor hotels are springing up along highways, in suburbs and in downtown areas. An adaptation of the motel has come to New York city, with several motor hotels going up on the west side of Manhattan.

A number of major hotels are being built in other cities, among them, Houston, Tex., where the Sheraton-Lincoln recently opened. An expensive and swanky new hostelry, the Georgetown Inn, has opened in Washington, D. C.

The Mississippi gulf coast boasts a new \$6 million resort, the Broadwater Beach hotel, which combines hotel, motel and private cottages on a 33-acre tract.

Abroad, hotels are being built in many of the major European capitals.

Europe's Tallest

The Knott hotels corporation is putting up the 24-story Westbury in Brussels. Scheduled to open next March, it will be the tallest hotel in Europe, with a restaurant at the top.

The government of Venezuela has built a luxury hotel on the seacoast near Caracas, which will be run by the Sheraton chain as the Sheraton Macuto. Intercontinental hotels, a subsidiary of Pan American World Airways will manage the Hotel Phoenix, which is scheduled to open in December in Beirut, Lebanon.

A new ski resort has been opened in Chile at La Parva, to provide summer recreation for skiers who like to keep in practice between winter vacations.

Hotels are being built or refurbished on the Egyptian Riviera near Alexandria, on the Mediterranean. New hotels also are available at Aswan and Luxor, within reach of temples, tombs and sacred valleys of upper Egypt, and skyscraper hotels are going up in Cairo, which offers a luxury inn at the airport and the Nile Hilton in the city. A unique Egyptian hotel, the Khased Kheir, which accommodates 60 guests, is a yacht once owned by former King Farouk.

Dublin Hilton Planned

From Dublin comes news that a 100-room hotel will be built on a 43-acre site near the city of Cork. A Dublin Hilton is on the drawing board as the ninth Hilton hotel in Europe.

Closer to home, on American territory, the Bluebird's Castle hotel at St. Thomas, in the Virgin Islands, has been remodeled into a luxury resort. The hotel is built around a castle once reportedly occupied by the legendary pirate Bluebird.

Puerto Rico has become a major tourist area. The H. R. Weisberg corporation is adding to the already considerable number of hotels there a new luxury ocean-front establishment in San Juan, to be called the Ponce De Leon.

The San Juan Intercontinental has been renamed the El San Juan hotel and is undergoing a \$5 million, three-year expansion program designed to make it the largest hotel in the Caribbean.

Darker Paints Show Popularity Increase
