

Daytime Activities During Festival Being Completed

Ashland—With final rehearsals underway at the Oregon Shakespearean Festival in Ashland, plans for extended daytime activities are being completed. The Festival, first of its kind in this Hemisphere, opens July 21 and continues nightly through Sept. 2. Rotating throughout the 44-nights will be "Comedy of Errors," "Henry IV, Part Two," "As You Like It," and "Coriolanus."

A special music-dance production, "A Thieves Ballad," will join the schedule Aug. 6 and will follow each evening's performance of "Comedy of Errors" thereafter.

Renaissance Schedule

The Festival's Institute of Renaissance Studies will maintain a full summer's activity schedule throughout the 1962 season. Institute Director Dr. Margery Bailey has arranged a fresh slate of popular side attractions to the summer productions.

Trinity Noon—coffee and dramatic readings sponsored by Beta Sigma Phi, women's service organization—will again be held on Wednesdays at Trinity hall in Ashland.

The Gresham Lectures on Tudor life and ideas will be heard each Thursday afternoon in the Ashland library assembly room. Special gallery and book exhibits will also be offered the public during the season.

Sunday Concerts

Sunday concerts of music and dance will again highlight the Festival season. Slated for four performances July 22, Aug. 5, Aug. 19, and Sept. 2, the popular series will be seen this year at Ashland's Old Presbyterian church, within walking distance of the Festival Theatre.

In addition to the slate of Ashland-based activities, three stimulating tours will be available to Festival patrons. Fully guided, reasonably priced, and convenient to the visitor's theater plans, the tours will depart regularly from Ashland and Medford to Crater Lake, the Oregon Caves, and the historic goldrush town of Jacksonville. Tickets for all three tours will be available at the Mark Antony hotel in Ashland and Jackson house in Medford.

A full listing of the Festival's daytime activities will be available at the theater box office. The flyer includes information on other Rogue valley events, including summer-long art exhibits and other special attractions.

PP&L Becomes New Society Member

Total advertised value was \$38,060. The value based on the highest bid was \$120,260.

Other companies bidding included Pine Mountain Lumber company, Yreka; Van Vleet Wood Products, Arcata; and George Harshman, Ashland.
