Bias Toward Mexicans Told

Portland — (UPI) — A restaurant owner charged here Wednesday that Mexican transient laborers were being discriminated against in Eastern Oregon.

The charge was made by Gilbert Lopez, the owner of the Morocco club in Nyssa, before the Oregon Liquor Control commission.

Lopez sought a license from the commission for his business. He said the Nyssa city council turned down his request for a license several times.

He told the commission that the laborers were unable to meet socially in the Boise valley area because of discrimination against them by bar and club owners.

He said he sought a license so that transients would have

a place of their own to congregate although there would be no discrimination.

The commission advised Lopez to submit a written application for a license.

The OLCC also heard the semi-annual report from H. J. Detloff, hearings commissioner. Detloff said that cases involving the sale of liquor to minors had shown an increase of 15.6 per cent during the past six months.

He added that 140 licenses were cited with failure to use the statement of age form required when identifying persons of doubtful age.

PGE Pact With Canby Approved

Salem — (UPI) — Jonel C. Hill, Oregon public utility commissioner, Wednesday approved a service area agreement between Portland General Electric Co., and the city of Canby, setting out territories to be served in the Canby area.

It was the first such agreement to be filed between a private company and a municipality under the 1961 certification law.

The agreement stipulates that PGE will not serve any new customers within the Canby city limits and the city's power agency will not serve any new customers in PGE territory around the city.

Liz Taylor Refused UAR Travel Visa

Rome — (UPI) — Actress Elizabeth Taylor has been refused a visa to travel to the United Arab Republic where her co-star, Richard Burton, is completing filming of the picture "Cleopatra," informed sources said today.

The UAR Embassy spokesman confirmed that Miss Taylor had applied for the visa before she left for Gstaad, Switzerland, Wednesday.

He said he did not know the outcome of the application but other well informed sources said it was turned down.

In Cairo, the newspaper Al-Ahram said the government banned Miss Taylor because

she is on the Arab League blacklist for "promoting the sale of Israeli bonds." An Interior Ministry spokesman declined to comment.

Miss Taylor, who has converted to Judaism, has had all her films banned in the UAR.

Seattle Man Sentenced

George John Victor, Seattle, Wash., was sentenced to six months in the Jackson county jail in district court this week for petty larceny.

Victor pleaded guilty to charges of taking a one-half inch drill from a construction company here.
