

Ailments Traced to Tensions in College

New York (UPI)—A 10-year study conducted among students at the University of Wisconsin shows emotional problems the third most common academic ailment. The most common: respiratory infections; next, skin diseases.

Dr. Alfred S. Evans and associates, reporting in "The Archives of Environmental Health," a journal for doctors, said the high incidence of emotional problems may be traceable to the greater likelihood of such problems occurring among university students.
