Highway Work Progressing in Jackson County

The Jackson county engineer's office has reported several road and one bridge project under way.

Grading is continuing on the Evans Creek rd. between May's creek and Ramsey Canyon.

Grading is being done along Evans creek, County Engineer Robert J. Carstensen said. In the same area, three-fourths of a mile of the Evans Creek rd. is being relocated to eliminate two small bridges.

Paving is continuing on the Butte Falls-Fish Lake rd., Carstensen said. Paving of Laurel st. in Butte Falls was scheduled to start today.

Resurface Junction
"We are in the process of preparing three-fourths of a mile of the Dead Indian rd. for resurfacing in the vicinity of Hyatt rd. junction," the county engineer said.

A steel bridge is being erected over Butte creek on the Netherlands rd. Steel trusses have been installed. Timber for decking is expected some time next week, Carstensen said. Work on the decking will start about Aug. 1.

Road crews are now graveling the base on the South Fork of Little Butte Creek rd. The bridge over Lake creek on the south Fork of Little Butte creek rd. is now open to travel, the county engineer reported.

Safety Record in City Declining

Medford's traffic safety record for the first six months of 1982 shows a steady decline over a similar period last year, according to Chief of Police Charles P. Champlin.

So far this year a total of 565 traffic accidents within the city limits have been reported to Medford police. Of these, two involved fatalities, 86 involved personal injury, and 477 accounted for property damage.

Since the first of the year, two persons have died and 106 injured in automobile accidents, including 88 motorists, and 18 pedestrians. During the same period in 1981, 63 motorists and seven pedestrians were injured.

"Our traffic safety record can be improved only by the earnest cooperation of every local motorist and pedestrian in careful observation of the traffic laws and thoughtful consideration for the rights of others," according to Chief Champlin. "Common sense, common courtesy and regard for traffic laws are three strong factors in making driving safer for everyone," he said.
