MEDFORD**Blood Requested For Peruvian Boy**

Salaverry, Peru.—UPI—Doctors aboard the hospital ship Hope sent an urgent appeal to drug companies in the U.S. today for a special type of blood plasma they hope will save the life of a 12-year-old boy with hemophilia.

The plasma will be used to supplement whole blood transfusions being given almost constantly to tiny Santos Narvaez, whose courage has captured the hearts of the doctors and nurses of the floating hospital.

Santos has been bleeding since Wednesday of last week, when surgeons operated to remove a badly infected bone from his left thumb.

He has received 16 transfusions of whole blood, including one donated by Dr. J. Mayfield Harris, Los Altos, Calif., the surgeon who performed the operation.

The Peruvian army volunteered donors. Despite the willingness to help, there has been difficulty in securing a sufficient number of donors with the right type of blood.
