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Post Office Has Necessary Legal Authority To Deal With Obscene Matter Through Mails

Editor's note: Some church leaders and members of Congress have expressed fear that the Post Office Department's drive against mail order obscenity may be crippled by a recent Supreme Court decision. In the following interview, Postmaster General J. Edward Day says the drive is still in high gear and won't be affected by the court ruling.

Washington — (UPI) — Postmaster General J. Edward Day said today the Post Office Department has all the legal authority it needs to continue a hard-hitting campaign against purveyors of pornography.

He discounted fears voiced by some church leaders and members of Congress that the drive against mail order obscenity may be crippled by a recent Supreme Court decision.

On June 25, the court ruled, 6 to 1, that the Post Office was wrong in barring from the mails three magazines which featured nude male photographs. The government contended that the magazines had a lewd appeal for homosexuals.

The decision was greeted by protests similar to those evoked by the prayer-in-schools ruling which the high court issued the same day.

Receives Many Letters
The Most Rev. Robert E. Lucey, Roman Catholic archbishop of San Antonio, Tex., said it would "hamstring" Post Office enforcement efforts and "throw our children to the wolves of obscenity."

Rep. George Wallhouse (R-N.J.) predicted in Congress that a "flood of obscene matter" would soon be pouring through the mails.

Day disclosed in an interview that he has been hearing from many other Americans — members of Congress, religious leaders and private citizens in all parts of the country — who are under the impression that the court decision knocked the legal props from under his anti-smut campaign.

"Actually, it hasn't affected us at all," he said. "If anything, this ruling is a mandate for us to continue the approach we've been using for the past 18 months."

Relies on U.S. Code
He explained that the Post Office has two ways of dealing with obscene material.

One is to bar it from the mails by administrative order. The other is to bring criminal charges against the people who send pornography through the mails.

Arthur E. Summerfield, postmaster general during the Eisenhower Administration, relied heavily on the administrative approach. It was Summerfield, for example, who issued a 1960 order barring the three allegedly homosexual magazines from the mails.

Day, a lawyer in private life, decided when he took office in January, 1961, to discontinue the administrative method and rely exclusively on criminal prosecutions under Title 18 of the U. S. Code. This statute provides fines up to \$5,000 and up to five years in prison for persons convicted of mailing obscene materials.

Set Aside Order
In its June 25 ruling, the Supreme Court set aside Summerfield's order banning the three magazines. But the justices were sharply divided.
