Festival Actor Speaks at Rotary. All speechmaking is persuasive in some degree, Peter MacLean, now appearing at Ashland in Oregon Shakespearean Festival plays, said in an address Tuesday before the Medford Rotary club.

MacLean, who is instructor of speech and drama at the University of Suffolk, Medford, Mass., and of Emerson college, Boston, spoke at a luncheon meeting at the Rogue Valley Country club. Techniques employed by the veteran actor and instructor in teaching speech were outlined, including extemporaneous speaking, commentary, "off the cuff" discussion and manuscript reading. The objectives are selling one's self to an audience and motivating thoughts and actions.

Satire, MacLean said, is a basic tool of persuasive speech and effective speaking is increasingly important in today's life with the growing importance of radio, television, the stage and movies. Commenting briefly on the 1962 season of the Oregon Shakespearean Festival association at Ashland, the speaker lauded the choice of
