Feeding the Family

Canned Meats Popular in Satisfying Main Dish Meals
In salads, canned meats being already cooked are as easy to add as spices. A crisp, well-dressed salad is hearty and satisfying when a generous amount of meat is added. Many families are discovering this boon this summer.

Most popular canned meats include luncheon meat, cured pork, cured beef, corned beef, corned ham, corned beef in various styles. Luncheon tongue, ham, frankfurters and Vienna style sausages are all good. Canned hams, chicken and turkey are convenient, often very inexpensive salad enhancers.

Canned meats easily chilled in refrigerator for one to two hours. To remove from can, open both ends completely and push out the meat using end piece as pusher.

Hot Potato Salad
Many good cooks like to offer one hot dish along with the cold foods even on a very hot day. A surprise hot dish in the best tradition is hot potato salad. We suggest that you make it like this - top it with canned Vienna sausages arranged in wheel-spoke fashion. Recipe makes six generous servings.

Cook five or six medium size potatoes (about two pounds) in skins until tender; peel and dice. Put in 1 1/2 quart casserole; add one-half cup diced celery, one-quarter cup finely chopped onion. Sprinkle with one teaspoon salt.

Melt four tablespoons butter; add two tablespoons flour, one-quarter dry mustard, three tablespoons sugar, one teaspoon salt and stir to smooth paste. Add one-quarter cup vinegar, one-quarter teaspoon Tabasco. Cook, stirring constantly until mixture thickens and comes to a simmer.

Four over potatoes; sprinkle with one tablespoon finely chopped parsley. Mix lightly with fork being careful not to break potatoes. Let stand one hour. Arrange contents of two cans Vienna sausages on top of salad in wheel-spoke fashion. Cover and reheat in moderate, 375 degree oven, 20 minutes.

King-Size Ranchburgers
Make Fine Filler-Upper

Restaurant sandwiches often are King size. We chose this restaurant sandwich specialty for pleasing forever-hungry boys because one such sandwich will make a meal when accompanied by a pitcher of milk and perhaps a fruit assortment on second thought, if the boys are teen-agers, add a big package of potato chips and a dozen or so cupcakes.

Good party fare, here too when the clan gathers. This loaf of French bread and 1 1/2 pounds of ground beef will make 4 generous servings.

Cut one loaf enriched French bread into eight 1/2-inch thick slices, eight inches long. Mix 1 1/2 pounds ground beef, one-half teaspoon salt, one cup finely chopped onion; shape into four patties eight inches long, same size as bread slices. Brown patties on one side; turn, season browned side with garlic salt and top with grated cheese. Cook until cheese melts and meat is thoroughly cooked.

Butter and toast one side of bread slices; place patties between toasted slices. Four servings for hungry people as we said.

Crisp Cabbage
Plentiful crisp cabbage is so good just like this. Wash cabbage, cut into quarters and shred on very coarse part of grater. Cook uncovered in minimum of rapidly boiling salted water for five minutes; add butter, salt and pepper. Serve at once.

Creamy Cucumbers
For perhaps eight generous servings of creamy sweet-sour cucumbers as perfect accompaniment for halibut, salmon, flounder or other west coast caught fish, try this relish:

Blend two tablespoons vinegar slowly into one-half cup heavy cream; add 1 1/2 teaspoons sugar, three-quarter teaspoon salt, one-eighth teaspoon paprika and 1 1/2 tablespoons instant minced onion. Set aside several hours in refrigerator to chill. Thinly slice two or three (according to size) unpeeled, chilled cucumbers and add to sauce. Sprinkle with paprika or chopped parsley.

August Abundance
Cantaloupes and fresh peaches head the nation's list of plentiful as western grow.

Abundance of Juice
There's super abundance of frozen concentrated orange juice, fresh and processed lemons and limes which means they are being specialized.

Vegetable bins are heaped high with practically every known vegetable.

Templing turkey is being featured by most markets because of super abundance. Certainly the best buy for feeding family, church, grange or other groups.

Broiler-fryers are priced so low that we don't see how it is possible to grow and market them for so little. For picknicking, there's nothing to beat broiled or fried chicken. For making chicken salad and sandwiches, stewing chickens are bargains.

Vegetable fats and oils of all kinds for cooking and for salad dressing making are plentiful, wearing lower prices.

Dairy products and eggs are always bargains in good nutrition. Cottage cheese and cheddar are faithful standbys for many a good meal. Be sure to keep plenty of milk and ice cream on hand for refrigerator raiders. Imitation ice cream, by the half gallon, is super for the making of cola, rootbeer and other beverage "floats".

That warrants for the costs of the aforementioned construction shall bear interest at four per cent (4%) per annum and shall constitute general obligations of the City of Medford, and said warrants shall be issued pursuant to the provisions of the Oregon Revised Statutes, 287.202 to 287.310, inclusive.

That the Recorder-Treasurer is hereby directed to give notice hereof upon the property owners affected by publishing this ordinance once in a daily newspaper, printed, published and of general circulation in said City, at least ten (10) days before the date of said meeting, and to post five copies of this ordinance in five public and conspicuous places in said City for a period of ten (10) days prior to said meeting.
