**Battalion, Southern Oregon Men Given Commendations**

With an overall rating for staff performance of 95.66 per cent, the second battalion, 414th regiment, 104th division, topped all other battalion units at the summer encampment at Camp Roberts, Calif., according to Lt. Col. John F. Rush, Medford.

The second battalion, composed of men from the Rogue valley, Grants Pass and Klamath Falls, won the Col. Edwin B. Nelson award for the outstanding battalion of the 414th regiment, Col. Nelson, recently of Salem, was the former commander of the 414th regiment (BTC).

Major Gen. Eugene G. Cushing, Vancouver, Wash., commanding general of the 104th division, stated in an address to the troops that the regular Army evaluators considered the division's use of training aid, its methods of instruction and the procedures and techniques used in training as superior in many instances to that displayed by the regular Army personnel. The 104th division was regarded by the evaluators as one of the outstanding divisions on the west coast and among the top training divisions in the nation.

**Evaluators**

The U. S. Continental Army command evaluators composed of brigade and battle group commanders from Fort Ord, Calif., cited all units of the second battalion for the Department of the Army's certificate of meritorious performance for the work done at the summer training camp. The awards will be made in the near future. The units and the commanders are Company E, First Lt. Dean Ruffner, Medford; Company F, Capt. Ted McDaniel, Medford; Company G, Capt. Eldon Everton, Grants Pass; Company H, Capt. Jack Moebius, Klamath Falls; and Headquarters Company, Capt. James D. Straus, Central Point.

Lt. Col. Rush stated that the achievement of the second battalion at Camp Roberts, "was the result of team-work and an all out effort by everyone in the command."

**Superior Rating**

The second battalion was given a superior rating for its staff performance. Col. Rush signaled out for special commendation members of the battalion, Capt. James D. Straus, operations officer, Central Point; First Lt. Howard N. Ritchey, assistant operations officer, Grants Pass; Specialist First Class Robert C. Tugman, battalion sergeant-major, White City; Staff Sgt. Ronald L. Von Der Hellen, operations sergeant, Central

Point; Staff Sgt. Adolph Larson, Medford, supply sergeant. Specialist Four Clifford D. Ambers, Klamath Falls, Company H, won the battalion's

outstanding soldier award for his work at the summer session. The second battalion's rifle team won the General's match

in competition with all other units of the 104th division. Members of the championship rifle team are First Lt. Donald W. Johnson, Staff Sgt.

Douglas C. Ustad, Grants Pass; Company E, First Lt. Robert D. Murphy, Staff Sgt. Richard J. Swinney, Specialist Four William B. Katzen-

bach, Medford, Company E, and Specialist Four Norman Hooper, Medford, Company G, First Lt. Donald W. Johnson, Grants Pass, Company

E, was third high in the individual scoring for the division. Several members of the team will be selected to compete for the 104th division in the Sixth Army rifle match to be held at Fort Lewis, Wash., in October.

Brig. Gen. William H. Prentice, Medford, recently designated senior assistant commander of the 104th division, stated that the training session "established a new high in military proficiency on the part of the entire division."
