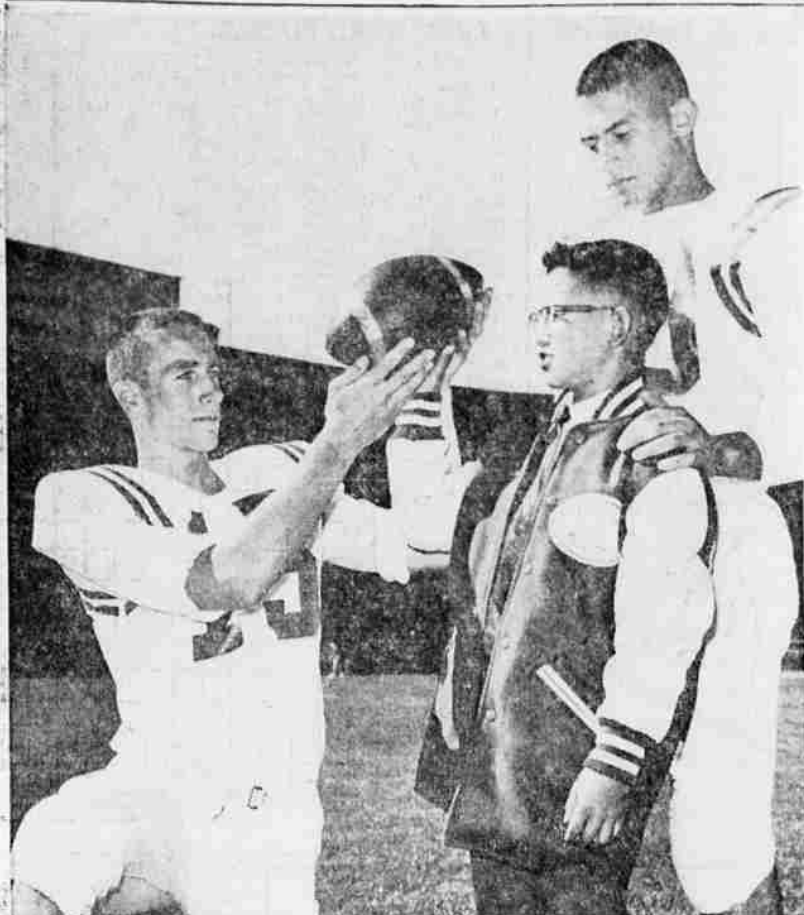

Chief Gridders Report On August 24; Misener, Morris New RR Coaches

Rogue River — Candidates for the Rogue River High school football team have been asked by new Head Coach Wayne Misener to report on Friday, Aug. 24, for physical examinations and issue of equipment.

They are asked to be on hand at 6 p.m. Practices will open on Monday, Aug. 27. Misener succeeds Delmer (Bob) Sandgren, who took a post at Molalla. A 1958 graduate of Chapman college, Misener was promoted from an eighth grade teaching post. He will be a mathematics and world history instructor in the high school. Last school year he coached freshman basketball and helped with high school football, having charge of the junior varsity football team.

Misener was graduated from Jacksonville High school in 1948. He was on the Red-skins' state Class B championship football team that year.

At Rogue River Misener will be assisted in football by Frank Morris, who will be head track coach of the Chieftains. Morris is a 1951 graduate of Medford High school where he was a three-sport athlete and a state champion hurdler. He was graduated from University of Oregon in 1960 and last year was football and track coach at Powers High school.

Rogue River will open its season at Glendale on Friday night, Sept. 14.

Fernandez, Phil Moyer Vie Friday

Eugene — (UPI) — Hard-punching Florentino Fernandez and local favorite Phil Moyer tangle in a 10-round middleweight fight at the Bethel baseball park here Friday night.

Fernandez, a Cuban who now lives at Miami Beach, Fla., is favored against Moyer, the older brother of high-

ranking middleweight contender Denny. He scored a fifth-round technical knockout over Phil in November of 1960.

But the muscular Cuban has been beaten in his last three fights. He dropped a split decision to Gene Fullmer and suffered TKO losses to Dick Tiger and Joey Giambra.

Moyer, who resides at Eugene, has scored four wins in five fights since coming out of retirement last April and posted a unanimous decision over Sugar Ray Robinson last month.

Fernandez is ranked as the seventh middleweight contender by the National Boxing association and owns a 30-5 record. The Oregon fighter is 27-6-1.

Promoter Ingo Lucchesi said he expects a crowd of more than 8,000 for the 15,000-seat park.

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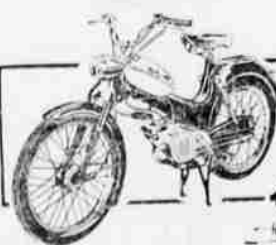
