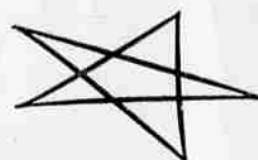


FOUR-H CLUB, F.F.A. FAIR

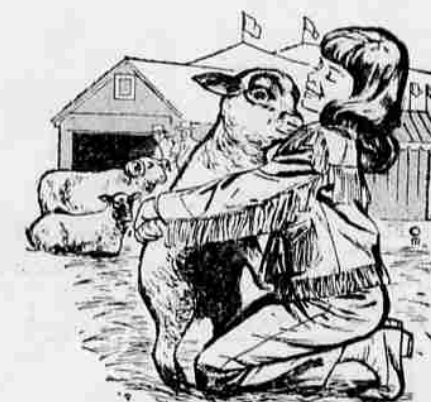
