An estimated crowd of 400 people watched Kathy Schroeder, Westside, win the champion sheep showman at the Antelope 4-H pre-fair held at the Elbert Bigham ranch July 25.

Other champion showman were Georgia Hubbard, Antelope, in dairy and Peggy Ross, Sis-Q, in beef. Top livestock judge was Mary Ann Cantrell, Ruch, with 296.8 points of a possible 300.

Peaches Used As Base For Cigarette Filter

New York — UPI — A 48-pound bushel of peaches could supply enough cellulose to make the basic filter material for 3,800 cigarettes, according to the Brown & Williamson Corp., which introduced the vegetable compound filter in one of its brands just 10 years ago.

The basic substance of this material, now used in virtually all major filter cigarette brands, is found in all forms of plant life.
