Hubbs tied the 12-year-old record of Red Schoendienst of the St. Louis Cardinals Tuesday by racking up two put-outs and four assists without a bobble to complete his 57th consecutive errorless game.

Today he could better the mark since Tuesday was the "big one" for him.

"I didn't feel the pressure until about the last two games," he said. "But before yesterday's game I just knew I wouldn't make an error. The pressure was pretty bad Monday and I didn't get much sleep Monday night but I just had confidence that I wouldn't miss one."

"I just wanted to tie the record so if I make an error today it won't bother me. I'd like to go on, but there's no pressure on me."
