

Mattress Labels Suggested for Bedside Reading

New York—Some time on your pillow, or your mattress, when you're short of bedside reading, you might try what's in more than four-fifths of

the states, the manufactured articles of bedding and upholstered furniture must bear a tag telling the buyer what's inside the cover, latex foam, urethane foam, horsehair or whatever.

Chances are fairly good that the tag may still be on the article, even though you may have owned it for some time. The tag says "do not remove under penalty of the law," and while it hardly would apply after the article reaches the ultimate consumer, and although the provision was intended for the seller, the injunction seems to discourage many housekeepers from doing away with it.

Law Goes Way Back
Most of the labeling laws date back many years; in New York State, the government includes a division devoted to enforcement here.

At present, the information on the tag, for the business-minded individual, may also give a clue to the tug of war between the makers of latex foam rubber and those of other foam products to gain the upper hand in the upholstery business.

Robert L. McCann, director of the Division of Upholstery and Bedding, New York Department of State, has said that there are many variations in the state labeling laws.

Some require that manufacturers tag upholstered furniture or bedding with labels giving the names of the fillers, others specify that percentages of each material used as filler be listed.

These differences may not always appear significant to the consumer, just so long as he has an idea from the label about what he's getting. To a manufacturer who merchandises in several states, it may be important, because failure to observe the regulations exactly could result in goods being declared "off sale."

In New York State, McCann's division acts as a clearing house for manufacturers here to make differences clear in various state laws. A manufacturer in doubt about regulations can go to his own state law division here, or in other states, and a division official can contact another state. McCann said that in 1961, state agents made 20,549 visits to inspect merchandise on store premises and placed 48,230 units off sale for various violations.

NO FAIR

Wardrobe Tips For College Given Students

Plan your wardrobe: Note the occasions in your life that influence your clothing selection, such as school, church, sports and dates. Determine how many outfits you need for each occasion.

List Clothes: List the clothes you now have and rate each item by its condition—good, fair or old. Line up your ideal wardrobe with the list of clothes you have and you have a wardrobe plan.

Have a wardrobe of interchangeable, such as blouses, skirts, sweaters, shirts and slacks that look well together. This will make your wardrobe go further and seem larger.

To stretch your wardrobe budget, buy clothes with a double purpose. A classic style wash and wear raincoat will be equally at home at school or on a date. An all-weather top coat with a zip-in lining will also span the seasons.

Tag Chart
Tack a color chart on the inside of your clothes closet. It will keep you from reaching for the wrong accessory and will remind you to buy clothes that are color keyed to the rest of your wardrobe.

Dress appropriately for the occasion. For church functions, boys should wear jackets and girls should wear gloves and higher-heeled shoes. Spectator sports call for informal school attire. Dates require a suit and tie, with dressier clothes for the girls.

Once you've carefully selected your outfit, forget it, says Gevathor. Confidence and ease go together when a teen-ager is well dressed.

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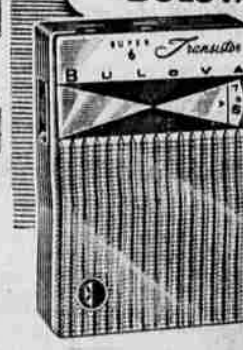
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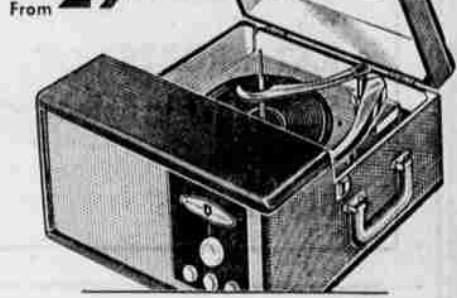


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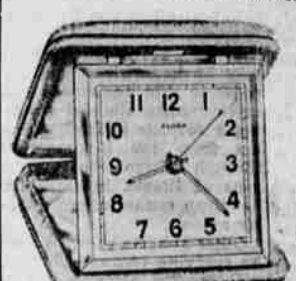
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
