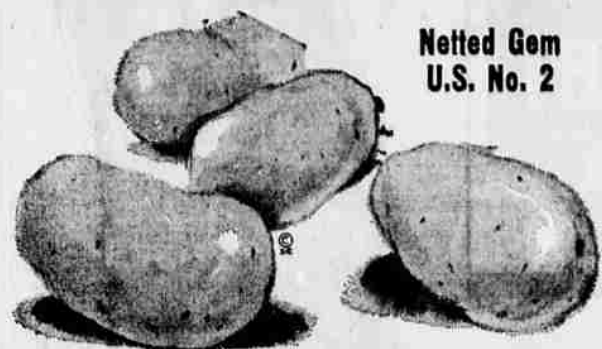

**Japanese Forester  
To Lecture at OSU**

Corvallis—A Japanese forester, Professor Ayaaki Okazaki of University of Kyoto, has been named visiting professor of forestry at Oregon State University for the coming year.

He will deliver a series of lectures and conduct seminars at OSU during the first months of 1963.

An internationally known forester is brought to the OSU campus each year under the visiting professor program sponsored by the Louis W. and Maud Hill Family Foundation of St. Paul, Minn. The Foundation also provides scholarships, fellowships, research grants, and adult education programs in the interests of advancing forestry in Oregon.

Professor Okazaki has traveled throughout the world, including two trips to the United States earlier, and has lectured at German forestry schools. He teaches courses in the management of Japanese forests at University of Kyoto.

Foresters who were visiting lecturers at OSU earlier included: D. S. Jeffers and Leo A. Isaac of the United States; Thorsten Streiffert, Sweden; Fritz Fischer, Switzerland; Eino Saari, Finland; and Eric C. Mobbs, Wales. All have served in professional, advisory, and research forestry capacities around the world.
