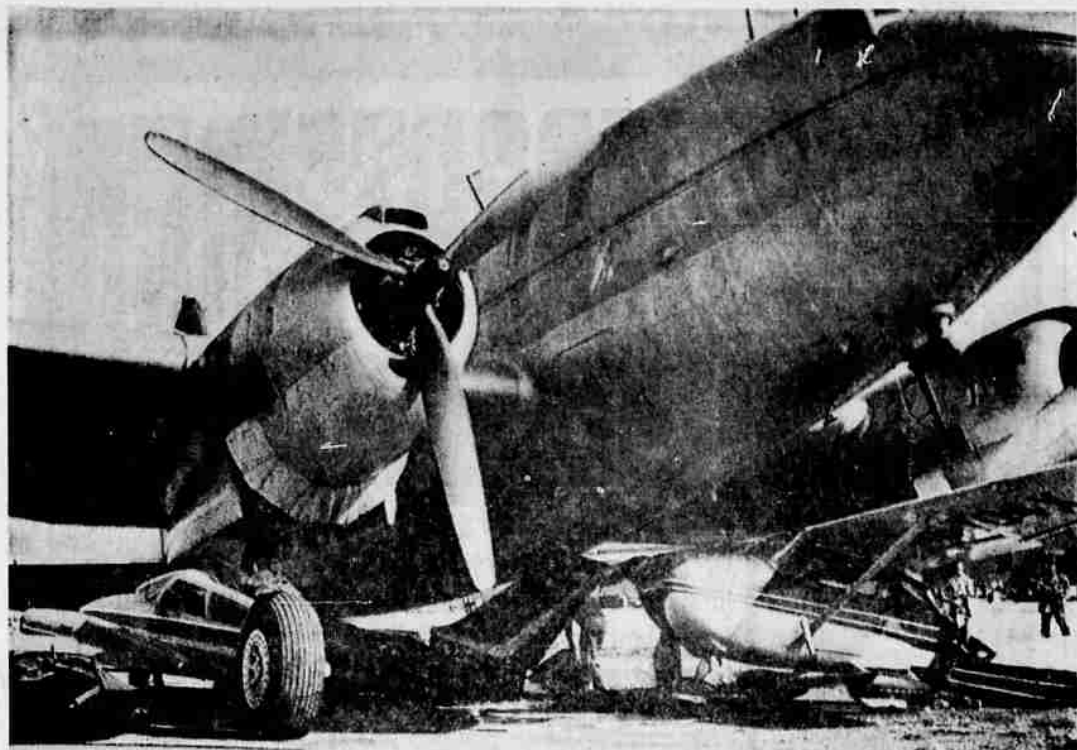

Zilka Smither Is Bought by Firm

Zilka Smither and company, Oregon investment banking and brokerage firm, with head offices in Portland, has been acquired by First California company, west coast investment firm, the companies announced Monday.

The local office of the firm is at 14 South Central ave.

The joint announcement was made by John F. Egan, president of the First California company; and James H. Zilka, president, Henry J. Zilka, and Arthur W. Smither, board chairman of Zilka Smither company, all of Portland.

Acquisition of the five offices of the firm increases the representation of First California company to 32 offices.

Richard Watson, vice president and manager of the Medford office of Zilka Smither company, has been appointed manager of the Medford branch of First California company.

First California company was organized in 1919. It is a member of the Pacific Coast Stock Exchange, the Midwest Stock Exchange, and is an associate member of the American Stock Exchange.

Drivers Reminded Of School Speeds

Jackson county drivers have been reminded that resumption of school means school zone speeds again apply.

Oregon law designates 20 miles per hour as a reasonable speed when passing school grounds or school crossings when children are going to or from school or during recess periods.

Area law enforcement agencies said the first few weeks of school usually present special problems for both drivers and children. Drivers forget school has started, and children forget to watch out for cars in the excitement of play or going to and from home.

Law officers and their departments will give special enforcement attention in school areas, but urged each driver to take it upon himself to police his speed near schools.

1 APRICOT PUNCH

2 oz. Old Mr. Boston Vodka

2 BLACK RUSSIAN

Pour:

On ice cubes in Old Fashioned cocktail glass.

3 BLOODY MARY COCKTAIL

1 1/2 oz. Old Mr. Boston Vodka
1/2 oz. Tomato Juice
1 Dash Lemon Juice
Shake well with cracked ice and strain into Old Fashioned cocktail glass with cube of ice.

4 MOSCOW MULE

Into a Copper Mug, put:
1 1/2 oz. Old Mr. Boston Vodka
Juice of 1/2 Lime
Add ice cubes and fill with ginger beer. Drop lime in mug to decorate.

5 SCREWDRIVER

Put 2 or 3 cubes of ice into 6 oz. glass. Add 2 oz. Old Mr. Boston Vodka. Fill balance of glass with orange juice and stir.

6 TWISTER

2 oz. Old Mr. Boston Vodka
Juice of 1/2 Lime
Pour into 12 oz. Tom Collins glass. Add several cubes of ice, drop red into glass. Fill with Seven-Up and stir well.

7 VODKA AND APPLE JUICE

Put 2 or 3 cubes of ice into a 6 oz. glass. Add 2 oz. Old Mr. Boston Vodka. Fill balance with apple juice and stir.

8 VODKA AND TONIC

Cube of Ice
Use 12 oz. Tom Collins glass and fill balance with quinine tonic and stir.

9 VODKA COLLINS

2 oz. Old Mr. Boston Vodka
Juice of 1/2 Lemon
1 Teaspoon Powdered Sugar
Shake well with cracked ice and strain into 12 oz. Tom Collins glass. Add several cubes of ice, fill with carbonated water and stir. Decorate with slice of lemon, orange and a cherry. Serve with straws.

10 VODKA COOLER

Into 12 oz. Tom Collins glass, put:
1/2 Teaspoon Powdered Sugar
2 oz. Carbonated Water, and stir. Fill glass with cracked ice and add 2 oz. Old Mr. Boston Vodka. Fill with carbonated water or ginger ale and stir again. Insert sprig of orange or lemon peel (or both) and dangle end over rim of glass.

11 VODKA STINGER

1 oz. Old Mr. Boston Vodka
1 oz. Old Mr. Boston Creme de Menthe (White)
Shake well with cracked ice and strain into 3 oz. cocktail glass.

12 VODKA DAISY

Juice 1/2 Lemon
1/2 Teaspoon Powdered Sugar
1 Teaspoon Grenadine
2 oz. Old Mr. Boston Vodka
Shake well with cracked ice and strain into stem or 8 oz. metal cup. Add cube of ice and decorate with fruit.

13 VODKA SOUR

Juice 1/2 Lemon
1/2 Teaspoon Powdered Sugar
2 oz. Old Mr. Boston Vodka
Shake well with cracked ice and strain into 6 oz. sour glass. Fill with carbonated water and stir. Decorate with half-slice of lemon and cherry.

14 VODKA MARTINI-VODKATINI

Traditional (3 to 1)
1 1/2 oz. Old Mr. Boston Vodka
1/2 oz. Dry Vermouth
Dry (5 to 1) - 1 1/2 oz. Vodka, 1/4 oz. Dry Vermouth
Extra Dry (7 to 1) - 1 1/4 oz. Vodka, 1/4 oz. Dry Vermouth
Stir well with cracked ice and strain into pre-chilled 3 oz. cocktail glass. Serve with olive or twist of lemon.
