

Grandstand Dedication Slated Friday; Tornado Engages Bucs

The brand new 4,000-seat grandstand at the Medford Senior High school stadium will be presented to the student body and in turn to the school district tomorrow night, just before the kickoff of the Medford-Marshfield football game. Ceremonies are set for 8 p.m.

Eugene Or., chairman of ticket sales and finance, for the stadium campaign, will present the grandstand deed to Garner Haupt, student body president in exchange for a \$1 check. Then Haupt will present the deed to Keith Hockersmith, chairman of the Medford school board.

Other participants in the short ceremony will be Russell Acheson, assistant superintendent of Medford schools;

Bud Parsons, president of the Lincolnbucks club; Miss Janet O'Sullivan, student body secretary, and the Medford High school band under direction of Irv Merrick.

First Use
Teams will have their warm up prior to the dedication and will leave the field just prior to the ceremonies.

The concrete grandstand, erected at a bid price of \$88,500 and valued at around \$100,000, will be used for the first time as the Black Tornado entertains a traditional non-conference and overtime state playoff foe, Medford's regular season with the Pirates has come to its big game outside the Southern Oregon conference slate.

Friday's encounter will find

the Tornado trying to extend and the Coss Bay team trying to snap a four-year Medford winning streak over the Pirates. Over the past four seasons The Hurricane has tamed the Pirates six times, twice each in 1958 and 1959 and one apiece in 1960 and 1961.

Medford showed fine potential last week end as it thumped The Dalles 27 to 0. Marshfield turned in an exhibition of power as it clubbed Klamath Falls 25 to 7.

No Better Game
On the strength of pre-season predictions and on the basis of last week's play, the two schools are rated among the top grid powers in the state.

Oregon Journal coaches board rankings had Marshfield tied for No. 1 and Medford rated No. 3. The Oregonian's poll of sportswriters put Marshfield No. 2 and Medford No. 5.

The "acas, then, while strictly for prestige, will be one of those of interest to fans throughout the state. Dr. Leonard Mayfield, Medford superintendent of schools, in extending invitations to the dedication to Portland sportswriters, said, "We could not have selected a better game at which to dedicate the new stand."

George Pasero, sports editor of the Oregon Journal, wrote, "In every way the Medford school system is one of the superior ones... athletically and academically... It's not surprising that outstanding school man Dr. Mayfield should see to it that Medford's grid plant be rebuilt."

Urge To Surpass
The stand was built by sale of tickets and by donations, without use of tax funds.

Said Leo Davis, prep sportswriter for the Portland Oregonian, "Medford owes its reputation for athletic and academic excellence to this sort of 'think big' programming. From the top where Leonard Mayfield sits as superintendent, down to the smallest member of the knot-hole gang, people in this southern Oregon city share the urge to surpass."

Medford Coach Fred Spiegelberg has reported that Mike Barnes, who broke his nose in practice last week and missed the game with The Dalles, is ticketed to start at right halfback against Marshfield. He said that guard Bill Buettner, out last week because of a neck injury, is back for action. However, tackle Gary Miller has had a strep throat and Larry Sander likely will start at the right tackle post.

Spiegelberg indicated that he will start with completely different platoons on offense and defense. He termed the defense crew "a bunch of rebels."

San Diego, Calif. (AP)—Six members of the pennant winning San Diego Padres were named Wednesday to the 1962 Pacific Coast league all-star baseball team by the league baseball writers' and sportscasters' association.

They were catcher Jesse Gonder, the league's leading hitter; first baseman Rogelio Alvarez; shortstop Chico Ruiz, who led the league in stolen bases; third baseman Tommy Harper, outfielder Ken Walters and righthanded pitcher John Taitouris.

Also named to the team were lefthanded pitcher Dick Egan and outfielder Stan Palys of Hawaii, second baseman Nate Oliver of Spokane, outfielder Walter Bond of Salt Lake City and utility infielder Dick Phillips of Tacoma.

Egan led the pitchers in victories and Palys led the league in home runs.

Concern in Raider Football Lair Over Game With Chico

Ashland—There appears to be some concern in the Southern Oregon college football camp over the Red Raiders' season opener here with Chico State.

That's the impression Al Akins, veteran SOC coach, gives as he continues to drill his squad twice a day in preparation for the Wildcat opener that will be held on Fuller Field, starting at 8 p.m. Saturday.

Akins, after viewing films of last week end's Alumni game which the varsity won, 27-19, stated, "We've got a

long way to go before Chico State."

Apparently the first practices this week showed just that.

"We're just not ready," was the way the Raider chief put it.

Hard To Pin Down

Injuries post no actual problem to the men of SOC this week. Only one, defensive guard Glenn Vandergaw, is sidelined right now, having suffered a shoulder pointer in practice last week which forced him to bypass the Alumni game.

"It's hard to pin down the reason that we are not ready right now," offered Akins. "Actually, I think that it's our mental attitude. We have no physical reason to be 'down'. Maybe it's just that we are feeling those first-game jitters."

Southern Oregon, the defending Oregon Collegiate conference champion, heads the week end opener mindful of the 27-0 licking the Wildcats handed them last year.

Over the past years of gridiron competition between the two intra-state rivals, Chico has won 12 games, lost 10 to SOC, and one game ended in a tie.

Last year Coach George Maderos' Californians had a 4-6 season record while the Raiders were 5-4.

EXPECT RECORD CROWD
