Book About Morse Said Not Violation

Portland—UPI—The book, "The Record of Morse," is not an anonymous publication and does not violate state law, the Multnomah county district attorney's office has ruled.

Secretary of State Howell Apppling referred the question to the district attorney's office after a complaint by Oregon Young Democrats.

Dist. Atty. Chester Peccore said his office found that the book contained the name of author Harrison Spangler at least twice, it contained the statement that he lived in Portland, and it contained the name of the firm which published it.

Peccore said it "quite clearly" did not violate the section of Oregon's corrupt practices law which prohibits use of anonymous matter in elections.

Haifield Upholds James Meredith

Salem—UPI—Gov. Mark Hatfield said Thursday night that the case of James Meredith in Mississippi was "not a case of states' rights but of human rights."

"If the constitution as interpreted by the U.S. Supreme Court is to be meaningful in the lives of each citizen and is to be applied equally regardless of geographical factors the choice is clear," the governor said.

Hatfield said economic measures could be taken to get Meredith, a Negro, admitted to the University of Mississippi.

"The alternative to military force would be the imposition of economic sanctions in withholding appropriations in every category except welfare for subsistence purposes," he said.
