Oregon Supreme Court Decisions

Salem—47. The following decisions were handed down by the Oregon Supreme Court Wednesday.

Theron F. Martin, appellant vs. Ore Insurance Co.; appeal from Multnomah county; opinion by Justice George Rossman; Judge Pro Tem Barnett H. Goldstein affirmed, an action to recover on a policy of accident insurance, judgment favoring the insurance firm affirmed.

Vera M. Rowley, appellant vs. Willard H. Rowley; appeal from Washington county; opinion by Justice Rossman; Judge J. S. Bohannon reversed, an order reducing child support required of Rowley from \$56 a month to \$25 was reversed.

Velma Freitag vs. Even Evenson and Euphemia Evenson, appellants; appeal from Marion county; opinion by Justice Gordon Sloan; Judge George R. Duncan affirmed, a judgment of \$3,054 recovered by the Freitag woman, a renter, for injuries suffered when she fell into a septic tank affirmed.

Leo Peter Senecchal Jr., appellant vs. Donald Bauman; appeal from Multnomah county; opinion by Justice Pro Tem Arno Denekke; Judge Alfred T. Sulmonetti affirmed, judgment for Bauman in a personal injury case affirmed.

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YOUR CAR and the LAW

Protection for Car Buyers

An Oregon State Police car rolls onto a main Portland thoroughfare that looks like "automobile row." It moves past several showrooms of new and used cars, then swings into a gas station and comes to a halt behind six parked cars of 1958 vintage.

After a brief interrogation, the station owner is informed he can be prosecuted for selling cars without a dealer's license.

The state has a two-man team—a state police officer and an investigator for the Department of Motor Vehicles—employed full-time enforcing Oregon's dealer license law, and helping to insure that Oregon title documents on motor vehicles are worth more than the paper they're printed on.

Enforcement of the dealer law is important to the would-be motor vehicle buyer. All

Winnie Ruth Judd Remains at Large

Phoenix—UPI.—The search for escaped trunk murderer Winnie Ruth Judd, 57, today centered in Phoenix although detectives said they were checking a report that the former "tiger woman" may have fled to Minnesota.

Police said they suspected the inmate of the Arizona State Mental hospital still was in the Phoenix area after reviewing information received in her latest escape attempt.

Police said past information indicated Mrs. Judd never learned to drive a car and when last seen had only \$5 in her possession which would rule out air or train travel to Minnesota.

Investigators also pointed out that in six previous escape attempts the woman never left Phoenix.

All available law enforcement officers were alerted to participate in the search for Mrs. Judd, who was convicted of slaying her two roommates in 1931. She was originally sentenced to hang but was judged insane and committed to the state mental hospital for life.

Her victims were Hedvig Samuelson and Ann Lerol, who lived with her in a Phoenix apartment.

The state team assigned to dealer enforcement and protecting the value of the Oregon title also makes frequent visits to wrecking yards to see that titles and license plates for vehicles that have been wrecked are turned in to the Department of Motor Vehicles.

There have been cases where title certificates on wrecked late-model cars have been improperly used as security for loans.
