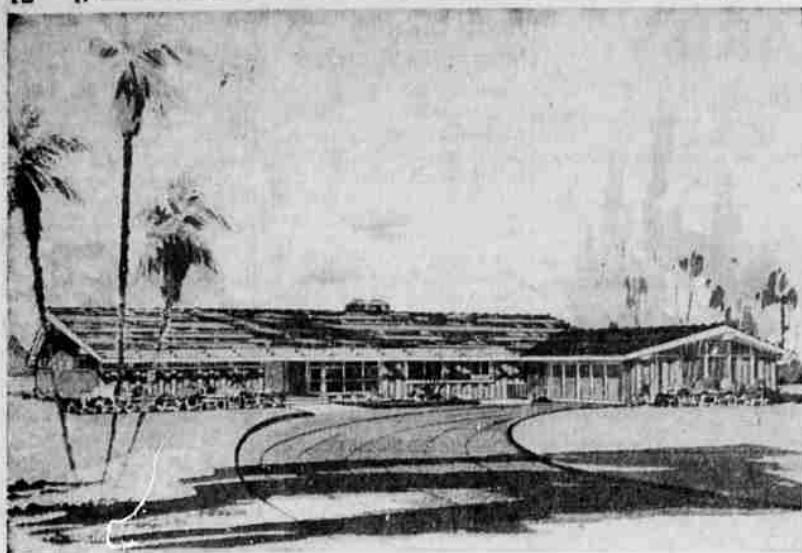




Eisenhower To Aid Campaign of Lodge Against Kennedy

Boston — Former President Eisenhower comes here next Monday to give a hand in friend George Cabot Lodge's Senate campaign against President Kennedy's youngest brother Ted.

The success of Eisenhower's visit and what he says in a major address could well determine whether the President will change his plans and come here to stump for Edward M. (Ted) Kennedy.

Lodge at this point is seen as a decided underdog and anything Eisenhower says in his behalf will be appreciated. He has demonstrated immense popularity in this state.

He carried Massachusetts by 445,007 votes in 1956 and by 208,800 in 1952, the same year that then Congressman John F. Kennedy was taking a U. S. Senate seat from Lodge's father, former United Nations Ambassador Henry Cabot Lodge.

Eisenhower will speak to an expected 4,000 at the Commonwealth Armory where he will be guest of honor at a "birthday dinner." The

speech will be carried live on television during prime evening time which the GOP bought. Eisenhower will be 72 next Sunday.

George Lodge, 35, will share

the head table with Eisenhower and the rest of the Republican state ticket. Thirty-year-old Ted Kennedy has other plans for that night — two rallies in nearby cities — but

he'll have one eye on the GOP gathering.

Although Lodge is the underdog, nobody is ready to count him out. Like Ted, he has a campaign schedule so geared that he will have visited every one of the state's 351 cities and towns before the Nov. 6 election.

Ted is made the current favorite on the basis of his tremendous primary showing in which he defeated Massachusetts Atty. Gen. Edward J. McCormack Jr., nephew of House Speaker John W. McCormack, by better than 2-1.

There is a third candidate, of unknown strength, in this Senate fight — Harvard University Professor H. (for Henry) Stuart Hughes, grandson of the late Charles Evans Hughes.

Hughes, an advocate of unilateral disarmament by the United States, collected 117,000 voter signatures to get on the ballot as an independent candidate and, in theory, each signature represents a vote.

The gubernatorial race seems certain to cause some

party line-crossing in the voting booths.

Democratic candidate Endicott Peabody, a one-time All-American at Harvard, is the first Protestant in decades to be nominated for governor here.

Republican Gov. John A. Volpe, seeking his second term, is the first Catholic ever selected by the GOP to run

for governor. He is the son of Italian immigrants and there are about 450,000 Italian-American voters, most of them Democrats.

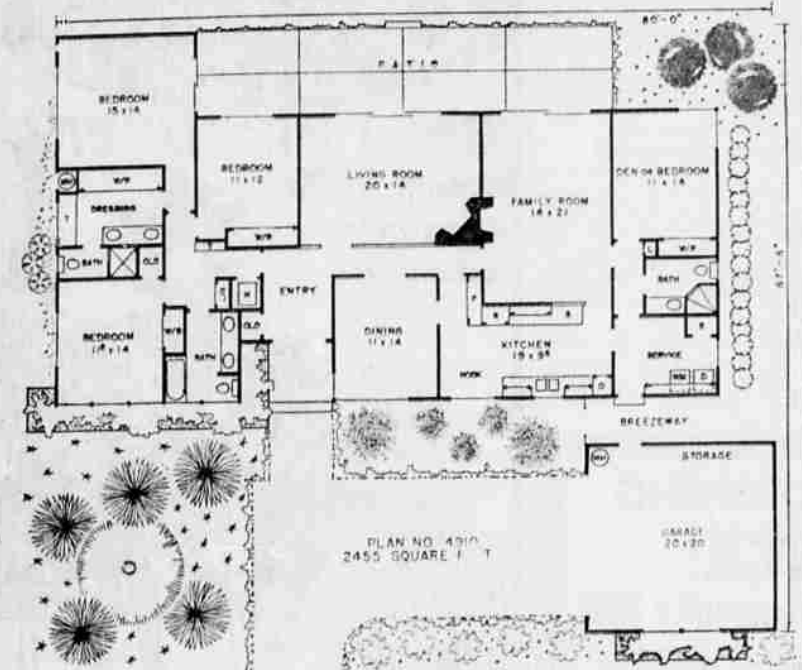
The state next January sends 12 instead of 14 congressmen to Washington. The redistricting pitted two incumbents, Democrat Thomas J. Lane and Republican F. Bradford Morse in a single district.

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This Week's House Plan Offering

Today any couple with children is confronted with a vexing domestic problem. How, under one roof, does one supervise the children when necessary, let them alone when desirable and still enjoy the luxury of adult activities?

This problem has been solved in this particular design by providing a spacious family room which is partially open to the kitchen. Mother can perform her kitchen activities and still supervise the children as they use the family room as a play area. This informal room can double as a TV room which is especially important when guests are being entertained in the more formal living and dining rooms.

Wide Pantry
The kitchen is located between the family room and the

large dining room. Note the extremely wide pantry and the generous size eating nook. By using a service cart, it would be very simple to serve outdoor meals on the wide patio which is accessible through the sliding glass doors in the family room. Similar doors open from the living room and master bedroom.

A roofed breezeway offers quick access from the garage to the roomy service. The laundry and broom closet are located in this area and there is additional space available for a freezer plus other items. A short hall connects the service, family room, bath and den or fourth bedroom.
