

Yemen Royal Family Sentenced To Death

Cairo (AP)—Yemen's Prince Seif Al-Hassan and 13 other members of the ousted royal family have been sentenced to death in absentia by a revolutionary tribunal in Yemen's capital, Radio Sanaa has reported.

Hassan, uncle of deposed Imam Mohammed Badr, had assumed the title of imam when his nephew was reported killed in the Sept. 26 palace coup. Imam Mohammed Badr then turned up alive and Hassan renounced his claim to the throne.

Revolutionary Premier Abdallah Sallal of the newly proclaimed "republic" confirmed the death penalties.

Telstar Satellite Said Obsolete

Salem (AP)—A man who was key in putting the telstar communications satellite into orbit has admitted that, in effect, telstar is obsolete.

Dr. D. A. Chisholm of the Bell Telephone Laboratories at Murray Hill, N. J., explained that in today's rapid developing technology, anything that works is obsolete, "and telstar works very well," he added.

This was his reply to a question by newsmen at a luncheon here concerning claims by Sen. Wayne Morse (D-Ore.) that present communications systems are either already outmoded, or close to being obsolete, because of new developments expected in the near future.

Dr. Chisholm also said there is a "glorious semantic argument on what is obsolete." He is on a tour explaining telstar.

SECTION 3. That warrants for the costs of the aforementioned improvement shall bear interest at four per cent (4%) per annum and shall constitute general obligations of the City of Medford, and said warrants shall be issued pursuant to, and on the terms and conditions set forth in, Oregon Revised Statutes 287.502 to 287.510, inclusive.

SECTION 4. That the Recorder-Treasurer is hereby directed to serve notice hereof upon the property owners aforesaid, by publishing this ordinance once in a daily newspaper of general circulation in said City at least ten (10) days before the date of said meeting, and by posting five copies of this ordinance in five public and conspicuous places in said City for a period of ten (10) days prior to said meeting.
