

## Number of 'Old' Students at OSU Increases Greatly

Corvallis-Oregon State university's new record enrollment of 10,032 this fall came more from increases in "old" students than "new," a report compiled by the registrar's office shows.

The number of new freshmen, transfer and graduate students (3,764) is up 4 per cent over a year ago, but the number of "old" students (6,268)—those who have attended OSU in a previous year—is up a record 16 per cent.

More students than ever before are back to continue their education, Registrar Wallace Gibbs said.

And to Gibbs and other university leaders who are deeply concerned about the giant "dropout" problem among U.S. college students, the "stay in college" increase is highly encouraging.

**Problems Colleges Face**  
It will add, of course, to the problems colleges face in coming years in having enough classrooms and housing to serve the increasing number of students, he said.

The number of "new" students will take a sharp increase each year starting in 1964 because of a major jump upward then in the number of Oregon high school graduates. These increases will then carry through the next decade.

The combination of more new and old students will almost double the number of students attending Oregon public colleges in 1972, enrollment projections now indicate.

OSU's enrollment this fall is almost exactly 1,000 more than a year ago. New student gains over a year ago account for 151 of the total and increases in the number of old students, 846 over 1961. The 1962 enrollment estimate for OSU, on which the biennial budget was based two years ago, was 8,345.

**Just As Capable**

A study made in 1961 at Oregon State university on drop out of students showed that "more than half of the students who drop out of college are just as capable academically as the ones who graduate." The study was made by Dallas Norton, personnel coordinator and director of admissions, and Richard F. Link, statistics professor.

"They compared college entrance examination scores, aptitude and proficiency tests, college grade performance and related measures of students who do-and don't-graduate."

"The fact that only about half of the brightest high school graduates go on to college has drawn wide comment and concern, but the tremendous and often needless drop out of capable college students before they get their degrees is equally tragic," Norton and Link reported.

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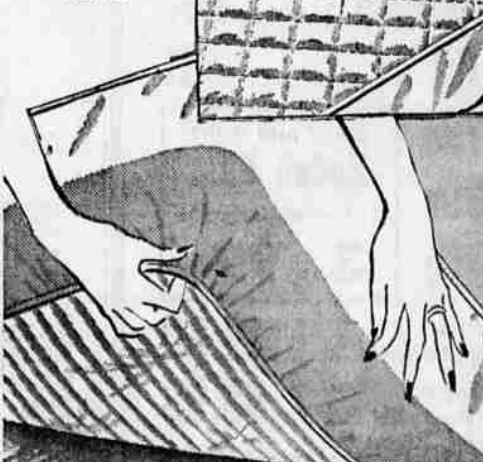
