Retail Stores Told of Rule

Salem—With Halloween just around the corner and other holiday seasons looming, the state department of agriculture reminds retailers of its ruling earlier this year on unwrapped candies sold in bulk.

The department has taken a dim view, as a result of complaints from consumers, of bulk unwrapped candy displays which permit buyers to serve themselves, says Kenneth E. Carl, chief of the dairy and consumer services division.

He suggests that stores selling unwrapped candies in the past through self-service put them in covered containers at the checking stand so clerks may scoop out and bag these goods.

Business Upturn In Mid-1963 Seen

New York—U.S. Commerce Secretary Luther Hodges predicted Monday "an acceleration of good business" would begin in mid-1963.

Hodges' appraisal of the state of business was at odds with recent predictions by some economists that the economy is headed for a downturn in the first quarter of next year.

He said the outlook now is for a continuation of the present "high plateau" of business activity.

Hodges, in New York for a series of speaking engagements, would not comment at a news conference on whether the easing of tension in the Cuban crisis would cause any upturn in business trends.

He said his prediction for gains in 1963 were based on the recently enacted business investment credit and the Treasury's liberalized depreciation allowances.
