

Anne Matthews On College TV Panel

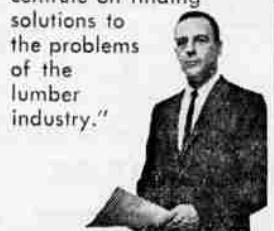

Candidate Pledges To Protect Funds

A promise to help protect O and C funds was made recently by legislative candidate Ed Branchfield in a speech before Upper Rogue Grange members.

"This golden nest egg provides Jackson county approximately \$2 million every year to finance the operation of our county government and to partially finance the operation of the various school districts in the county," Branchfield said.

"The other counties are trying to get this golden egg, or part of it, away from us. This must not happen," he declared. "Splitting up these funds may or may not be good for the state, but what is good for the state is not always good for Jackson county."

Thursday night the Republican candidate also attended the Medford Lions Pancake supper. Throughout the week he met voters informally during visits to Timber Products company, Kogap Manufacturing company, Elk Lumber company, and at coffee gatherings held by Mrs. Sam Harrison, 2125 Orchard Home dr., and Mrs. James Welch, Central Point.
