He had failed to obtain an absentee ballot in the hope that he would be released.

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Scranton Wins In Pennsylvania

Pittsburgh—(UPI)—William W. Scranton, 45, wealthy and a Yale man, won election as governor of Pennsylvania and became a Republican presidential possibility after only two years in politics.

Scion of a family which was a power in the GOP when Pennsylvania was a rock-ribbed Republican state, Scranton handily defeated former Philadelphia Mayor Richardson Dilworth, likewise a wealthy Yale man.

Returns from 8,934 of the state's 9,200 precincts gave: Scranton 2,319,247; Dilworth 1,859,509.

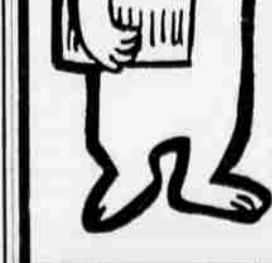

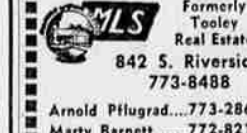
