Mr. L. J. — She absolutely refuses to do a thing around the house.

Helen J. — My studies come first. The house doesn't matter to me.

Mr. L. J. — My wife and I put in a hard day's work. I run a haberdashery and my wife comes in to relieve me for lunch and to help out when I get busy. We have an 18-year-old daughter who attends college.

Everything about Helen is satisfactory except for one blind spot. She won't lift a finger to help her mother with the housework. Her marks at school are excellent, her friends are the cream of the nice kids on top, she is respectful and friendly towards us. But if my wife is late getting supper, Helen would rather go without eating than start the meal herself. Her bed is never made. Her room looks like a haystack.

Whenever I remind her of her duty, she threatens to move out and go to live with her two girl friends who have their own apartment.
