NATIONAL FOREST TIMBER FOR SALE

Oral auction bids will be received by the Forest Supervisor, or his authorized representative at the office of the Forest Supervisor, Post Office Building, Medford, Oregon, beginning at 2:00 p.m. December 1, 1982, for all merchantable timber marked or designated for cutting on an area embracing 298 acres, more or less, within Sections 26 and 27, T. 12 S., R. 4 E., and Sections 2, 11, 12, 13, and 14, T. 13 S., R. 4 E., in the Rogue River National Forest, Jackson County, Oregon. The estimated volumes are: 1,000 M board feet of Douglas-fir and nine species; 4,500 M board feet of Shasta red fir; 520 M board feet of white fir and other species. The minimum acceptable bid per M board feet is as follows: Douglas-fir and nine species \$18.00; Shasta red fir \$20.00; white fir and other species \$20.00. This includes the following rates: per M board feet for stumpage, including stumpage, \$2.00; hauling, \$2.00; plus an additional \$2.00 for Douglas-fir and nine species; \$2.00 for Shasta red fir; \$2.00 for white fir and other species; and \$2.00 for slash disposal for all species. The stumpage rates payable for each species will be increased by the amortization rate in effect for that species when the unamortized estimated cost of the main haul roads has been amortized by timber sales. The unamortized estimated cost is \$25,731.00. Amortization rates are: Douglas-fir and nine species, \$12.01 per M board feet; Shasta red fir, \$6.11 per M board feet; and white fir and other species, \$4.27 per M board feet. Amortization of estimated main haul road costs is computed on 50 percent of the estimated timber volume. The purchaser may request that the contract provide for more amortization of the estimated cost of roads which must be constructed before normal logging operations will be possible. The prices bid for stumpage shall be considered as tentative rates subject to quarterly calendar adjustment upward or downward by 0.4 of the difference between the average of the monthly Douglas-fir Region Index, as calculated by the Forest Service, and the Western Pine Association Lumber Price Index for the three previous months, and Douglas-fir and nine species, 105.15(C), Shasta red fir, 105.00(A), white fir and other species, 92.90(A). Such adjustments in the price for stumpage shall be applicable to timber sold during the three-month period following the quarter for which the adjustment is computed. In no event, however, shall the payment rates for each quarter be less than the base rates as stated above. When the adjusted rates by species are lower than the base rates, the difference between the total dollar value of the timber cut at adjusted rates and at base rates for all species will not be increased above the base rates until the subsequent adjusted rates above the base rates for all species develop an accumulated total dollar value in excess of the total recorded accumulated difference for all species. Sealed bids will be publicly opened and posted at the office of the Forest Supervisor at Medford, Oregon, December 12, 1982. All those who submitted a satisfactory sealed bid will be permitted immediately to continue auction bidding. A money order, bank draft, cashier's or certified check in the sum of \$2,000.00 must accompany each bid, to be applied to the purchase price, returned, or retained for application to advance claim for damages, according to the conditions of sale. If requested by the purchaser, contract terms will permit felling of timber in advance of payment up to the value of the performance bond. If an oral bid is declared to be high at the closing of the auction, the bidder must immediately confirm the oral bid by submitting it in writing on or before the time specified in the oral bid. The right to reject any and all bids is reserved. Forest Service and terms for use in submitting sealed bids and full information concerning the timber, the conditions of sale and the submission of bids should be obtained from the District Ranger, Butte Falls, Oregon, or the Forest Supervisor, Medford, Oregon, before bids are submitted.
