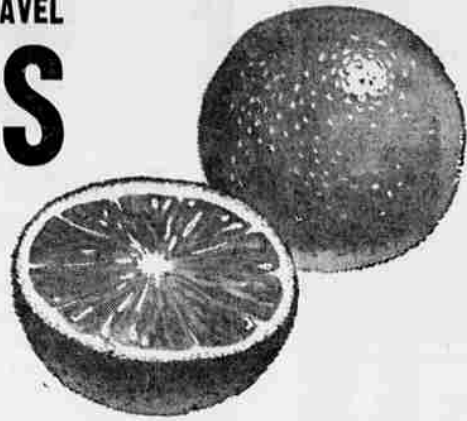

### Beware of Soviet Girls, Overseas Personnel Told

Washington—(UPI)—The Pentagon has ordered its personnel to ignore the beckoning glances of bewitching Russian beauties. Big brother, it said, may be lurking behind a two-way mirror.

The order was contained in Defense Department memoranda dealing with Communist espionage methods that might be used to trap U.S. military men or civilians working overseas.

The regulations prohibited "any sexual relationships whatsoever with Soviet or satellite citizens."

**Secretly Photographed**

There have been instances outside of spy novels, the Pentagon said, where Americans were plied with liquor and maneuvered into "sexual or homosexual activity" while being secretly photographed.

The pictures then were used to blackmail the Americans into spying for the Communists, it said.

The memos also warned of tie-pin microphones, miniature electronic transmitters hidden in shoe heels, and infra-red photography in the dark.

The Pentagon told of the two-way mirror, dear to the heart of fiction writers, which it said was used in motel rooms in several instances. It is glass treated to appear as a mirror in the room, but which can be seen through clearly by someone standing on the other side.

A case in point to prove Russia "bugging," the department said, was the 1958 visit of Vice President Richard M. Nixon to the Soviet Union.

U.S. officials staged a conversation in a room in which one official was referred to by a much higher rank than he actually held. The next day, Soviet officials addressed him with the higher rank and lavished much great courtesy upon him.

"It must constantly be remembered," the Pentagon said, "that Soviet bloc intelligence and security services carry their espionage activities to fantastic lengths. They are in fact used in day-to-day activities and operations."

### Developing Speech Subject of Meeting

Asland — "Parents should not be overly concerned about their children's speech unless it is severely inappropriate for their age, difficult to understand, or calling attention to the child."

Nearly 350 parents and teachers heard Dr. Leon C. Mulling, director of the Southern Oregon college speech and hearing clinic, develop this point at the Parent Teacher's association meeting recently at the Wilson school in Medford.

"Children are often delayed in their speech development," he said, "because there has been no reason for talking, not enough attention to speech in the home, poor speech models, too much babying, rejection of the children, hearing and physical problems, or because of miscellaneous emotional shocks and conflicts."

Avoiding such delays in speech development may be accomplished by parents in a number of ways suggested by the speaker: Give the child love, attention, and security; speak slowly and clearly to him at all times; be sensible and fair in your disciplinary methods; give him plenty of sound stimulation with games, stories, rhymes and songs; avoid asking him to "say" words; and avoid talking about him in his presence.

### Boy Dies During Game at School

Dallas, Tex. — (UPI)—The soft spiral sailed into Jerry Allman's arms and the W. H. Gaston Junior high school student dashed down the sideline for a touchdown.

"My heart feels like it is in my mouth," Jerry, 15, told a teammate. Then he collapsed. A few minutes later he died at a hospital.

A post mortem was under way today to determine what caused Jerry's death.

He had no history of a heart condition. He had been playing touch football. There had been no body contact.

The boy's sudden death stunned his schoolmates in the physical education class.
