Drugs May Leave Harmful Residue

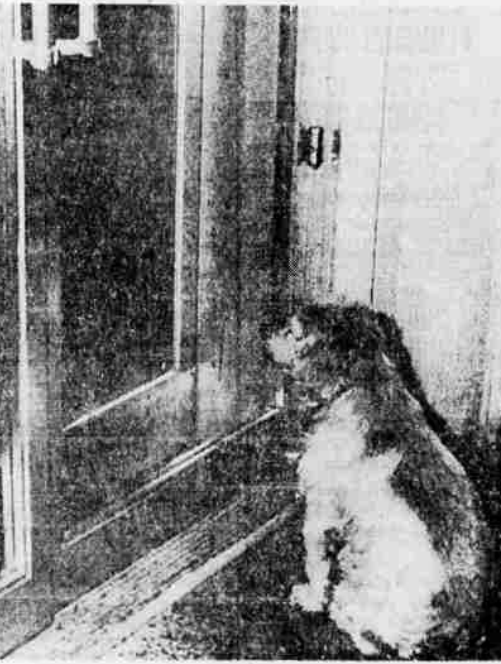
Chicago (UPI)—Insecticides, feed additives and therapeutic drugs given livestock may leave a harmful residue in meat animals "if they are not properly used," an Agricultural Department official has warned.

Dr. K. E. Taylor, of the federal meat inspection division, writing in the current issue of the Journal of the American Veterinary Association, urged Wednesday that tight controls be imposed on labeling of such products.

Taylor said that such drugs and chemicals are safe when given to livestock under the supervision of veterinarians but are potentially harmful when misused by farmers or feed processors.

He recommended that veterinarians "control, detect and dispose of animals suspected of having (drug) residues exceeding a safe margin."

He said the problem may become more acute in future years as new drugs and chemicals for disease prevention and growth stimulation in plants and animals come into use.

Brief Children On Hospital Stay

Urbana, Ill. - (UPI) - Children may react more favorably toward a hospital stay if they're cushioned for it in advance.

Mrs. Millicent Martin, child development specialist at the University of Illinois, says a child's idea of hospitalization may be different from that of an adult.

Since children usually can't visit hospitals, it's especially important for parents to explain what to expect. The best preparation is for parents to visit the hospital or find out as many details as possible from the doctor.

The child will want to know what will happen during the day, what his room will look like, what the doctors and nurses will do, how he will feel, and, of course, if Mommy will be there.

Answer the child's questions truthfully, but simply and calmly. Telling him things in a humorous way helps to build up favorable impressions. Still another way to help: provide him with a picture book about children's experiences in the hospital.

Let him help pack his things. Besides the necessities, include a few toys, books, and a favorite teddy bear or doll. Be sure you know what toys the hospital provides, if any, and what kind it permits.

Court Absolves Security Guard

Portland (UPI)—A six-member municipal court jury Wednesday found Erling Thoen, 61, a Wallace Security Service guard at the Oregonian building, innocent of a disorderly conduct charge.

The charge stemmed from the complaint of a picket, Charles H. Landis, 40, that he was struck by Thoen with an open hand Oct. 30.

The defense claimed Thoen acted "instinctively" after being jostled.
