A Flying Terminal

Dulles Airport Offers Lounge Ride From Terminal To Waiting Airplanes

Washington—(UPI)—An important event in commercial aviation is coming up this week and with it the formal dedication of the splendid new Dulles International Airport. I haven't seen the program yet, but I assume that President Kennedy will throw out the first stewardess, or something of that nature.

The ceremony will be followed on Monday by the official opening which will make it possible for passengers to miss connections at an airport specifically built for jet age travel.

Heretofore, they have had to miss connections at airports designed for propeller-driven aircraft and merely enlarged to accommodate jets. So this will be a big step forward.

Dulles airport was built by the Federal Aviation Agency to provide jet facilities for the capital area. I use the word "area" loosely.

It is located about 25 miles farther from the capital than is the old Washington National Airport. The simplest way to get from the capital to Dulles airport would be to go to National airport and catch a plane.

There is no connecting air service at present, however, so when the FAA conducted a press tour at Dulles this week I drove out by car.

Your first impression as you approach the Dulles terminal is that the roof is sagging. I was told, however, that the late Eero Saarinen, the terminal architect, designed it that way.

As I understand it, Saarinen wanted to give the building a soaring effect appropriate to its mission. In a pinch I suppose they could ground all the planes and fly the terminal.

At other airports, passengers have to walk from the terminal to the planes. At Dulles, they will ride in buslike contraptions called "mobile lounges," which have their own boarding ramps.

Rural Fire District Election Scheduled

The Medford rural fire protection district will hold an election Monday, Dec. 3, at Oak Grove school to elect three directors and to determine whether property located in the Griffin Creek area should be annexed to the district, according to C. W. Gueches, secretary of the district.

A petition has been filed with the district by owners of property along Griffin Creek road to include it in the fire protection district.

Already nominated to fill positions as directors of the district are Glen Allen, present director, for the five-year term; M. L. Priebe for a four-year term; and Kenneth Hulbert also a director, for a three-year term.

Petitions for additional nominations may be submitted to the secretary of the district 15 days prior to the election. Gueches said. Petitions must be signed by 15 electors in the district.

Polls for voting at the Oak Grove school will be open between 2 and 8 p.m.

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
