Ludwig van Beethoven appears in an unlikely place today - Walt Disney's Wonderful World of Color at 7:30 p.m. on KMED-TV. There's not a cartoon or trained animal in sight.

Disney travelled to Vienna to film "The Magnificent Rebel," a two-part dramatization of Beethoven's middle years, beginning with the composer's arrival in Vienna in 1792 to study composition with Franz Joseph Haydn.

As Beethoven, Karl Boehm, 33-year-old son of the former leader of the Vienna State Opera, heads the all-European cast. Musical portions of the program were recorded by the Berlin Symphony Orchestra in stereophonic sound. Beethoven works to be heard today and next Sunday include sections of the "Fifth Symphony," "Moonlight" and "Pathétique" sonatas, the "Pastoral" and "Choral" symphonies, and his opera "Fidelio."
