Shipley Ordered To Die in Gas Chamber Feb. 28

Newport, Ore. -UPI- Larry West Shipley, 21, stood before Lincoln County Circuit Judge Earl P. Conrad Wednesday and heard the judge order him to die in the state gas chamber Feb. 28.

Shipley, convicted of first degree murder for last year's fatal shooting of Linda Jean Stevens, 16, Willamina, was brought here late Wednesday morning for the setting of his execution date.

Judge Conrad set the date in the afternoon, and Shipley returned to the penitentiary in Salem at 5:04 p.m.

Shipley's conviction and death sentence is being appealed to the U. S. Supreme Court by the American Civil Liberties Union. The ACLU says there is a question over the fact that Shipley was held for a prolonged period before his appearance before a judge.

In Portland, Charles Davis, Oregon head of the ACLU, said the appeal was being drawn up and would be made shortly.

'Film Tests' Prove Effective in Class

Corvallis - "Film tests" are proving effective in teaching child care and family living at Oregon State university and originators envision that the tests may be used in the future for predicting whether some persons ought to become teachers, or whether employees are likely to get along with the boss.

The film tests are motion pictures made of child behavior or classroom situations that pose a problem or challenge for the teacher or person in charge.

In the classroom, the film tests are shown to students who then have to decide what should be done by the teacher or leader to handle the situation. The students' answers are compared in discussion periods with the opinions of a panel of experts.

Developed Four Years
The unique film tests were developed four years ago by Dr. Del Schalock, acting chairman of the department of family life at Oregon State university, in cooperation with Dr. Jack Edling of the center for teaching research, Oregon

College of Education, Medford.

They hit upon the idea of using motion picture tests to measure understanding of children's behavior. Since then, the films have been used by others in research projects.

A grant of \$44,000 has been received this year by Schalock to study the possibilities of using the films as predictors of classroom behavior of prospective teachers.

The films have proved to be a realistic and interesting tool in teaching students to understand children and how to handle them, according to Schalock.

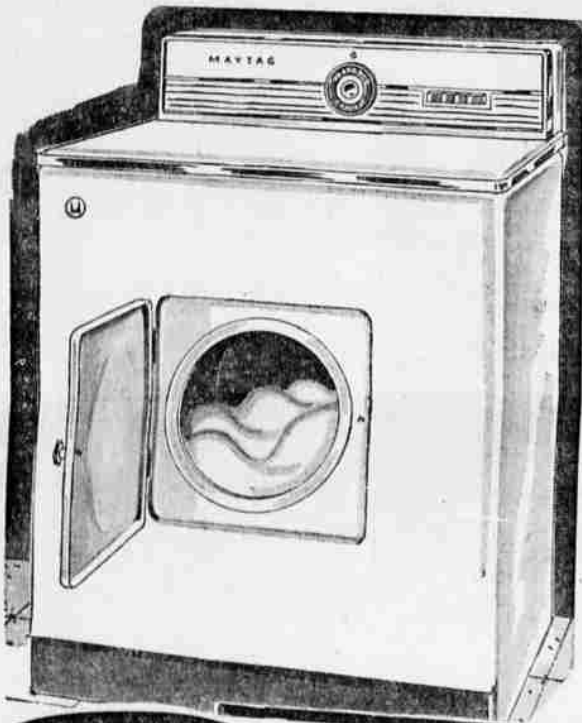
