Horseman's Group to Be Organized Tuesday

A southern Oregon horseman's association will be formed at 7:30 p.m. Tuesday in the Jackson county fairgrounds cafeteria, according to Larry Perry, 4-H horse club leader and breeder.

The group also will discuss possible fairgrounds facilities for horse activities and promotion of a new county fairgrounds. Everyone interested in horses has been invited to attend, Perry said.

Election Planned On Sewer District

An election will be held sometime early next year on the proposed formation of a South Talent Sanitary district.

Residents of the area involved voiced overwhelming at a hearing Friday their desire to hold an election as soon as possible. Twenty persons present favored formation of such a district, while only three opposed it.

The time and place of the election will be set by the Jackson county court.

The area in the proposed district lies south of the city of Talent between Interstate 5 and the Southern Pacific railroad tracks as far south as Jackson Hot Springs. Principally affected are residents living along Highway 99 and Old Highway 99 between the Talent city limits and the springs.

At Friday's hearing Judge Earl Miller explained that the voters in the area would elect a board of directors at the same time they vote on forming the district.

If the district formation is approved, the board elected would in turn work out details of installing a sewer system, including methods of financing, and could, if it wished, change the boundaries of the district.

Should the board find it not feasible to install a sewer system, the district could later be dissolved, Judge Miller said.

23 Influenza Cases Reported in County

Influenza, with 23 cases reported in the county, topped the list of communicable diseases during last week, according to Dr. A. Erin Merkel, county health officer.

Of the cases, 10 were reported in Central Point, 8 in Shady Cove, 3 in Ashland and 2 in Medford.

Four cases of chicken pox were reported three in Rogue River and the other in Medford, and three cases of mumps were reported. Two of them were in Medford and one in Eagle Point.

Of the other diseases reported there were on case each of infectious hepatitis in Medford, tuberculosis in Gold Hill and pneumonia in Ashland.
