

Kennedy To View Hole Blown in Nevada Desert

Washington — (UP) — President Kennedy will get a chance Saturday to inspect results of this country's first nuclear earth-moving project, the White House has disclosed.

From a low-flying helicopter the President will view a 1,200-foot-wide hole blown in the Nevada desert last July as part of Project Plowshare — an attempt to develop

peaceful uses for atomic energy. The so-called "Sedan crater," several hundred feet deep has been added to the President's itinerary for a week end western swing designed mainly to give Kennedy a first-hand check on progress in development of a nuclear powered rocket for space exploration. White House sources also

disclosed that as part of his inspection trip the President will view through a six-foot thick window disassembly of a prototype nuclear reactor for the rocket which this country hopes to put into space by 1967.

Remote Control Used
The Kiwi reactor, named for the bird that does not fly, was test-run for 260 seconds last Friday. It still is radioactively hot and its disassembly is being carried on by remote control.

The President will leave Washington by jet early Friday and will return on an overnight flight that will put him back at his White House desk Monday morning. After a fast round of briefings and inspections at Omaha, Los Alamos and Albuquerque, N. M., and Alabaster, Nev., the President will relax at Palm Springs, Calif., Saturday night and Sunday.

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Russia Seeks End Of Cuban Crisis

United Nations, N.Y. — (UP) — The Soviet Union was pressing Wednesday for a Security Council meeting to wrap up the Cuban crisis although U.S. demands still have not been fully satisfied.

Deputy Soviet Foreign Minister Vasily V. Kuznetsov gave U.S. Ambassador Adlai E. Stevenson a detailed schedule for the shipment of Russian IL28 bombers out of Cuba.

Cuban Ambassador Carlos Lechuga submitted to Secretary General Thant a draft of what informed sources said was the Castro government's conception of a crisis statement to be made at a Security Council session.

The United States, which does not favor a formal council meeting, was reported "unimpressed" with the Cuban draft.
