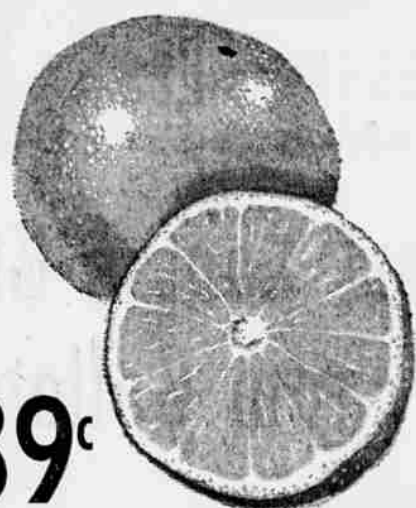

Goldwater Not To Be Candidate For Second Place

Phoenix — (UPI) — Sen. Barry Goldwater (R - Ariz.) said Wednesday he would not run for vice president in 1964 but will seek reelection to Congress.

"I don't want to run for the vice presidency and I won't run," Goldwater said. "I can't see anyone yet I could campaign with."

The senator answered with an absolute "no" when asked at a Phoenix Press Club forum if he would accept second place on a GOP presidential slate.

"After watching the greatest magician in the White House make LBJ (Vice President Lyndon B. Johnson) disappear, I don't want to become a zero," he said.

Congress Important
 "I like the Senate. I think the Congress is important and that's what I want to do. I hope to make it."

Shown a clipping from a national news magazine that speculated the Democrats considered Interior Secretary Stewart Udall as the best candidate against him in 1964, Goldwater said:

"I wouldn't miss that fight for anything."

Goldwater told a capacity audience he was a believer in party unity at election time and suggested that the Republican party might hold a national caucus in some central city such as Chicago to determine what the GOP is talking about.

"I think the so-called split in the Republican party is not worth worrying about," he said.

Hoffa Conspiracy Case Nears Jury

Nashville, Tenn. — (UPI) — The conspiracy trial of Teamsters union President James R. Hoffa may go to a federal court jury today.

Final arguments by attorneys and the judge's charges probably will consume most of today but the jury of seven men and five women is expected to get the case late this afternoon or early Friday.

Hoffa is named in a two-count indictment charging violation of the Taft-Hartley law. He has pleaded innocent. The maximum penalty on conviction of both counts would be two years in prison and/or \$20,000 fine.

Commercial Carriers Inc., a nationwide automobile transport firm named in one count of the indictment, has pleaded no contest. It could be fined as much as \$10,000.

Hoffa is charged with illegally receiving money from Commercial for insuring labor peace. Federal Judge William E. Miller is withholding judgment on Commercial until the jury returns a verdict on Hoffa.

Sheriff Plays Santa Claus Role

Napa, Calif. — (UPI) — Otis E. Calhoun and his bride-to-be, Miss Charlie Brown, will have a merry Christmas thanks to a Santa Claus dressed in sheriff's clothing.

Miss Brown sent a telegram to Napa county sheriff John Calhoun. In it she appealed for the release of "Otis E. Calhoun, 40, arrested Nov. 18 by the Highway Patrol on a charge of driving while intoxicated, and then sentenced to 90 days."

Her telegram continued: "We're engaged. If I were a little girl I would write to Santa Claus. But I believe that you, sheriff, are the only one who can help. We hoped to be married on Christmas Eve."

Miss Brown, who is secretary-treasurer of the city of Newton, Texas, received an answer Wednesday.

"Get out the wedding bells," said the sheriff's telegram. "Your 200-pound Christmas present is en route."

Pinball Machines Seized in Portland

Portland — (UPI) — Internal Revenue Service agents Wednesday confiscated five pinball machines from three Portland businesses.

Officials said the machines lacked federal gambling stamps.

The IRS said the seizures in Portland were part of a nationwide crackdown which stems from a federal court decision handed down in Kansas City last April.

The ruling upheld an IRS opinion that certain pinball machines are gambling devices and subject to federal tax.

The five machines confiscated in Portland were taken from three taverns.
