Hope Troupe Stops At Panmunjom

Panmunjom, Korea — (UPI) — Bob Hope and his entertainment troupe sang Christmas carols in this "no man's land" here today while North Korean guards looked on curiously.

Hope and his party made an unexpected trip to the border village this morning before they presented their Christmas day show at the 1st Cavalry division headquarters, 11 miles south of here.

Hope and members of his troupe including Lana Turner, Jerry Colonna, Anita Bryant and the Les Brown band, circled the brightly lit 25-foot Christmas tree and sang Christmas carols.

Health Information Center Organized

Corvallis — A health information center has been formed at Oregon State university to assist health education teachers in junior and senior high schools.

Answers to technical questions in hygiene and community health will be provided to teachers making use of the service. In addition, reference sources will be made available.

Establishment of the service was announced jointly by Dr. Benjamin L. Simmons, Salem, director of curriculum and instructional services, department of education, and Dr. C. L. Anderson, OSU chairman of hygiene and environmental sanitation.

OSU has more than 8,000 volumes and reference works which will provide material to answer nearly any question in the field of hygiene and community health.

On any controversial issue, it is planned to give all the information possible on both sides of the question, Dr. Anderson said.

Dr. Simmons said the question-answer service provided by Oregon State is not intended to be a service dealing with school programming, a function of the state department of education.

Longshore Strike In Full Effect

New York — (UPI) — Striking longshoremen, reinforced by support from maritime workers, brought to almost a complete halt today all activity at Atlantic and Gulf coast ports.

The only movement at nearly deserted piers from Maine to Texas came from skeleton crews manning ships tied up at docks and from watchmen guarding millions of dollars of cargo.

Even the token picket lines set up Sunday when the International Longshoremen's association went on strike, were dismissed so that the men could spend Christmas eve and day with their families.

William Perry, assistant to National Maritime Union President Joseph Curran, Monday announced the decision of his 50,000 member union not to cross ILA picket lines.

Union members on ships still at sea, Perry said, will stay at their posts until their vessels dock.

Thomas W. Gleason, ILA international vice president, said that the strike involving 75,000 longshoremen was 100 per cent effective.

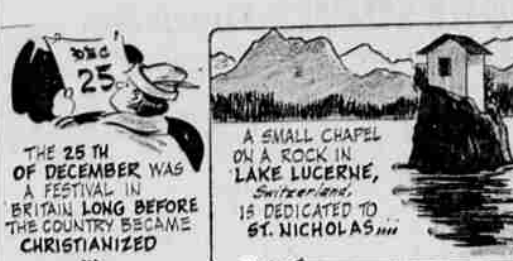
