**Khrushchev Seeks Problem Solutions**

Moscow — (UPI) — Soviet Premier Nikita S. Khrushchev appealed Monday for compromises as the only alternative to nuclear war to settle East-West problems.

Citing the agreements reached in the Cuban crisis, the Communist leader said the same "concession for concession" principle should be implemented in 1963 in efforts to solve such knotty issues as Berlin and disarmament.

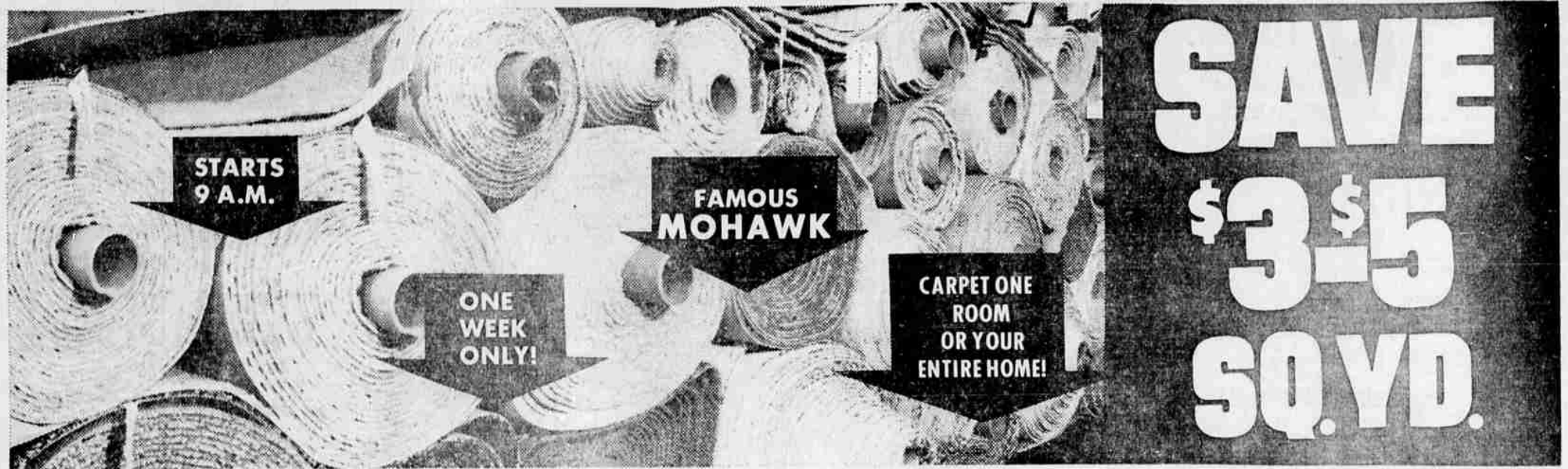
"The other alternative — which is thermonuclear war — must be ruled out," the premier said.

Khrushchev made his statements in an interview with the London Daily Express released by the official Tass news agency. The interview, in question and answer form, comprised a message for the new year.

The premier renewed his offer to stop Soviet nuclear testing, beginning Tuesday, if the West will do the same. But he made no new offer on the control issue. He also repeated his proposal to have United Nations troops replace Western garrisons in West Berlin as a compromise solution to the Berlin crisis.

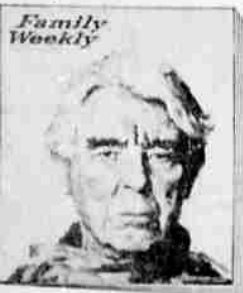
