

Study in Germany Planned as Part Of Music Program

Eugene - A year of music study in Germany is being planned as part of the University of Oregon's 1963-64 curriculum.

The program, announced this week by Dean of Faculty Robert D. Clark, is sponsored by the university in cooperation with the International Society for Music Education.

Financing of the program will be solely through fees charged to the students, with no cost borne by the State System of Higher Education. Cost of the year in Germany will be \$1980, plus the regular University tuition fee. Included in the total charge is transportation from New York and return, housing and meals in German homes, bus transportation in Europe to enable students to visit Switzerland, Austria, the Netherlands and France, and 30 to 40 attendances at operas, concerts, and festivals.

Cykler Named Director
Dr. Edmund A. Cykler, professor of music in the University, has been named director of the program of the University's German Center for International Music Education.

The program, as Dr. Cykler outlines it, will not be a tour but will be a part of students' educational experience. The curriculum will include 45 hours of credit in graduate and undergraduate courses, in music, music education, German language, and history, plus visitation and observation in schools at all levels, from kindergarten to university.

Students will also attend special lectures and conferences with music educators and critics and visit radio and television stations that engage in music education programs, in addition to the tours to several European music centers and the opportunity to attend musical events.

Limited To 30
Participation in the German program will be limited to 30 senior and graduate students in music.

The group will leave New York during the last week in September and spend nine months in Europe. Their German center will be in Oldenburg, Germany, site of a state teachers' training institute.
