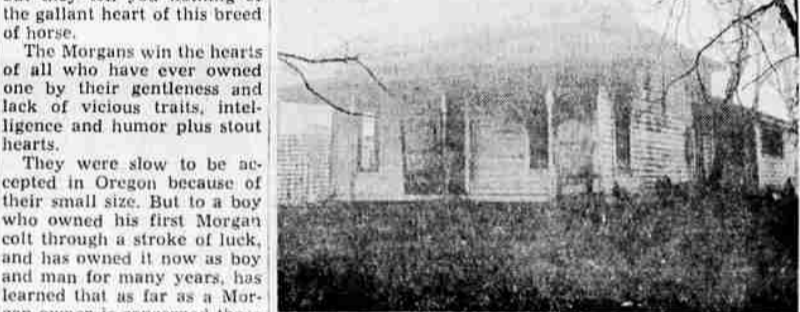
Women's Physical Fitness Class Opens
