Two Elections Set In Talent Area to Establish Districts

Talent—Two elections that will have a significant effect on the future of this area are scheduled in the Talent rural area this week.

Tomorrow, voters in an area south of the city will vote on whether to form the proposed South Talent Sanitary district. Polls will be open from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. at the Resmore motel, on highway 99 about half a mile south of the Talent city limits.

On Friday, voters in the rural area around Talent and also the south end of Phoenix will vote on the formation of the Talent Rural Fire Protection district. The election will be held at the old agronomy station on Colver rd, also from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Sanitary District
The proposed South Talent Sanitary district would stretch from the south city limits of Talent to a point south of Jackson Hot springs, running between Interstate 5 on the east and Old Pacific highway on the west.
If voters approve formation of the district, a three-man board of directors would investigate the feasibility of serving the area with a sewer system. Running for the board
