Medford Police Check 119 Major Crimes in Month

Some 119 major crimes, including 21 thefts involving more than \$50, were investigated by Medford city police during December, according to the monthly report released recently by Police Chief Charles P. Champlin.

Major crimes included nine cases of burglary, six of auto theft and 80 thefts of amounts less than \$50, according to the report.

Arrests for drunkenness during the month showed a pronounced rise. Sixty-two cases were reported last month, compared with 38 during the same month in 1961, and 49 during December, 1960.

Officers issued 103 citations for traffic violations during last month, also a marked increase over the two previous Decembers.

The most frequent traffic citation to motorists was for violation of basic rule. Some 104 were issued last month, the report showed.
