BLM Sells Four Timber Tracts

Four tracts containing 23,346,000 board feet of timber were sold by the Medford district of the bureau of land management recently.

The first two tracts, located in Jackson county, were purchased by Steve Wilson of White City, Elk Lumber company and Olson-Lawyer were the unsuccessful bidders on the first tract which brought a price of \$19 a thousand on Douglas-fir.

Cheney Forest Products was the unsuccessful bidder on the second tract of 3,262,000 board feet which sold for a total of \$45,247.30, \$24.60 per thousand on Douglas-fir was the high bid.

A tract located on Hawk creek in Josephine county was awarded to S. H. and W. Lumber company of Grants Pass at the appraised price.

Rough & Ready Lumber company of Cave Junction purchased a tract of 6,100,000 board feet located on the North fork of Thompson creek, Josephine county for the appraised price of \$127,891.60.

The Medford district will offer three tracts totaling 5,737,000 board feet Feb. 14. The appraised price is \$125,379.80. BLM officials said considerable volume of timber damaged by the Columbus Day storm is included in a tract located in Josephine county. The other two tracts are located in Jackson county.

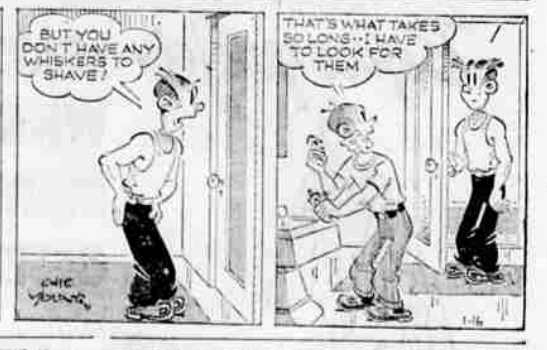

Safety Urged at Railroad Grades

January is one of the worst months for railroad crossing accidents, but all it takes to avoid most of them is a little common sense, according to Medford Police Chief Charles P. Champlin.

Champlin cited cases of motorists driving into the side of a moving freight train in broad daylight while railroad crossing signals were in full operation.

Crossing railroad tracks always involves potential danger, and especially so during winter months. Reduced visibility because of bad weather, distracting noises from the car heater and radio, a tightly-closed car and frequently cold and flu-stricken drivers often combine to "shut out" the sight and sound of approaching trains.

Chief Champlin advised area motorists to keep at least one car window slightly open to permit hearing train whistles and horns of other vehicles.

He urged extreme caution at all railroad grade crossings both guarded and unguarded. If there is a double track, always allow for the possibility that a second train may be coming in the opposite direction of the one that just passed.
