Kennedy Requests \$25.5 Million for Columbia Intertie

Washington—President Kennedy today asked Congress for \$25.5 million to begin construction of federal transmission lines to carry Columbia river power to California.

Kennedy also told Congress that "prompt action" was expected on legislation intended to assure the Pacific Northwest that power needed in the area would not be drained off through the intertie.

"The interconnections will provide for the sale and exchange of power between California and the Northwest, resulting in substantial economies to both regions," Kennedy said in his budget message to Congress.

A request for \$21.5 million for the intertie was included in a total of \$74,847,000 budgeted for the Bonneville Power Administration during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1963. An additional \$4 million for the transmission lines was included in the budget for California's huge central valley project.

Up Sharply

The BPA budget request, up sharply from this year's \$42.7 million, included nearly \$61 million for construction.

The funds budgeted for the West Coast intertie made up the biggest single item in the BPA request.

Interior Department officials said the BPA budget request also included funds for strengthening interconnections with Canada for exchange and sale of power under the Columbia River Treaty.

The treaty, not yet ratified by Canada, provides for the construction of storage dams by Canada. The United States would deliver power to Canada in exchange for benefits credited to Canada water storage.

Additional transmission lines also would be built to carry more power to industries in the Pacific Northwest.

Department officials said some 900 miles of high voltage lines and 11 new substations would be built for the BPA, which is responsible for the marketing of electricity produced at 22 federal hydroelectric plants.

The budget also included \$3.9 million for boosting the voltage to two 230-kilovolt lines to the Puget Sound area to 345 kilovolts in order to increase the capacity into the rapidly growing area.

Other New Facilities

Other new facilities planned to meet growing power loads included:

- Construction of a 25-mile 115-kilovolt line from Port Angeles to Sappho, Wash., to meet demands of the Clallum County Public Utility district, \$1.1 million.
- Use of the John Day-Keeler 500-kilovolt facilities to carry power from the John Day Dam to the Portland area, \$200,000.
- Additional transmission capacity to the Upper Olympic Peninsula area through the Bangor-Fairmount 115-kilovolt line, \$240,000.
- Additional capacity to the Okanogan River Valley in Washington through the Grand Coulee-Okanogan 115-kilovolt line, \$570,000.
- Construction of a 25-mile 115-kilovolt line from Fairview to Bandon, Ore., \$530,000.
- Construction of a 21-mile line and substation near Dorena, Ore., to serve Lane County Electric Cooperative, \$250,000.
- Increased capacity to McMinnville, Ore., \$160,000.
- Construction of a substation to serve the Inland Power and Light Co. REA cooperative near Pullman, Wash., \$85,000.
- Construction of a substation and short section of line near Dayton, Wash., to meet needs of Columbia REA cooperative, \$335,000.

Constitution Draft Changes Predicted

Salem — UPI — Senate President Ben Musa said Wednesday he is "not opposed to altering" the Oregon Constitution.

However, Musa said he thinks it would "be impossible to pass the proposed revision" that has been submitted to the 1963 legislature by the Oregon Constitutional Revision commission.

Musa predicted the revised draft will get a "rough going over" because of individual opposition to specific sections. "Some changes should be made," he said, "but they can be made piece-meal and can be accepted."
