OSU Bulletin Gives Information on Wills

Corvallis—'You can't take it with you' but you can have a personal hand in the disposal of your worldly belongings if you have a bonafide will, Oregon families are offered information on wills as a help in financial planning in a new Oregon State university extension bulletin, 'A Will of Your Own.'

The bulletin was produced as part of the OSU Extension Service program in family finance. It was written by Mrs. Dorothy Sherrill Miller, extension home management specialist, and has the approval of the Oregon State bar and its committee on public service.

In 20 pages, families can learn basic information about wills as a means of distributing their estate, become familiar with legal terms commonly used in estate planning, and prepare themselves for a visit to a lawyer in the event they wish to have a will of their own.

Agency Warns of Solicitations

The Guide Dogs for the Blind agency in San Rafael, Calif., has reported receipt of information that solicitations are being made in the Medford-Ashland area for the 'purpose of paying transportation costs of sending dogs back to the San Rafael school for guide dog training.'

This solicitation is not authorized, the agency said. There is no authorized solicitation of funds being made for their organization in this area, the agency said.

The school pointed out that the future guide dogs are either picked up by a representative of the school or they are shipped air freight to the school.

The last group of pups to be returned to the San Rafael agency from the Ashland area was picked up by a licensed trainer from the school June 5, 1982. Among the pups was golden retriever Lee, later assigned to Pianist Composer George Shearing and graduated with him Dec. 8.

At present there are several puppies in the Jackson county area but none ready to return to Guide Dogs for the Blind Inc., for training, according to William F. Johns, executive director.
