Number of Veterans Is Declining, VA Reports

Portland—There are 243,000 living veterans in Oregon and 22,225,000 in the nation as of the beginning of 1963, R. J. Novotny, manager of the Portland Veterans Administration regional office, has reported.

This compares with 22,735,000, the all-time high in national veterans population, in March, 1958. It will be approximately the year 2008 before the total drops to 4,429,000, the population level figure on the morning of Dec. 7, 1941, he said.
