Index of Characteristics Would Ease Problems of Identification

Washington — (UPI) — Shortly before the opening of Congress, when the pundits and gossip writers were making predictions concerning the new session, I climbed out on a limb with a forecast of my own. I predicted that it was going to be difficult to learn to recognize all of the newly elected senators and representatives who were then arriving to claim their seats.

I based this daring prophecy on the fact that the photographs submitted by members of Congress for publication in the pocket congressional directory frequently are misleading.

The photographs might show luxurious tresses cascading from pates that actually had since become bereft of foliage. Or they might gloss over such distinguishing features as dewlaps, crow's feet,

bifocals, porcelain dentures and other marks of maturity.

It turned out that my prediction was more accurate than I had anticipated.

This year we had 68 new House members and 12 new senators. To the average newsman who covers the Capitol, only about six were familiar figures, give or take Ted Kennedy.

During the opening exercises and at subsequent meetings, a number of my colleagues in the press galleries kept copies of the pocket directory at hand to aid in identifying the newcomers.

Suppose, for example, that you were trying to identify a representative with a rather prominent proboscis. Rather than having to thumb through the directory to find his likeness, you would turn to the index and locate "Roman noses."

There you would find listed all of the congressmen who are blessed with this patrician feature. There might be a hundred or so, but only a few would be first-termers, which would narrow the search.

Then you would look in the index under "far ears," and that would narrow it still further. Then you would go on through the listings for "double chins," "thin lips," "heavy beards," "receding hair lines," "shifty eyes" and so forth.

This way, by the process of elimination, you would finally find your man. He would be the congressman whose handsome portrait you had missed in the photographic section.

Negro Presses for 'Ole Miss' Entry

Attorneys for a young Negro who wants to be the second of his race to enter the University of Mississippi were to take their case into federal court today.

U.S. District Judge Sidney Mize was to hear motions that Dewey R. Greene be admitted to "Ole Miss" immediately and that University Registrar Robert Ellis be found guilty of contempt for rejecting him.

Greene, a 29-year-old Navy veteran, submitted an application last fall but it was turned down.

He showed up on the campus last Thursday when Negro James Meredith was registering for his second semester and Ellis personally rejected him.

The following day William Higgs, a white lawyer from Jackson, filed the motions on Greene's behalf.

A bill that would increase income taxes 20 per cent in order to bring a 10 per cent reduction in local property taxes in ready for introduction in the Oregon legislature. The bill provides for distribution of the money thus raised to counties on the basis of the relation each county's assessed valuation, before state equalization, bears to the state's total assessed valuation.

It's a reshift. Presumably, it would be welcome to property owners.

But let's not get too much excited. EVERYBODY pays his share of ALL taxes, because taxes are a part of the cost of production, and so have to be added to prices.

Reshifts of that sort go back to the kitten chasing its tail. A lot of activity is generated, but the kitten doesn't get anywhere much.

Another example of the same principle is this so-called LIBERTY amendment to the U. S. constitution — which proposes, among other things, to repeal the 16th amendment, thereby prohibiting federal income, estate or gift taxes. If these taxes were forbidden, and the spending went on unchecked, other taxes would have to be levied. The only way to lower taxes is for government to SPEND LESS.

I SUPPOSE you've been reading about this stockpiling ruckus that is going on in Washington. Maybe you wonder what it's all about.

Let's put it this way: When our early ancestors living out in the wilderness thought they were likely to be attacked by the savages, they laid in extra supplies of powder and lead in order to have plenty of ammunition on hand if and when the shooting started.

That's the theory of government stockpiling. In principle, it's wise — just as wise as were our ancestors when they laid in extra supplies of powder and lead in order to be sure of having plenty on hand if and when bad trouble started.

BUT — The trouble with government stockpiling is that when the NEED for it ends the government goes right on LAYING IN MORE POWDER AND LEAD — because if it didn't go on buying the PRICE MIGHT GO DOWN and so the party in power would lose the votes of the powder and lead producers.
