Bill Would Allow Payments by Army

Street improvements in Medford and a number of Oregon cities would be affected by legislation co-sponsored by Sen. Wayne L. Morse (D-Ore.) and Sen. Lee Metcalf of Montana.

The bill is one enabling the Army to contribute to the cost of improvement of certain property, even though it has no real estate interest in the property.

It will permit the Army to pay its share of street and sidewalk improvements made adjacent to U.S. Army reserve installations to the same extent as other property owners, Morse noted.
